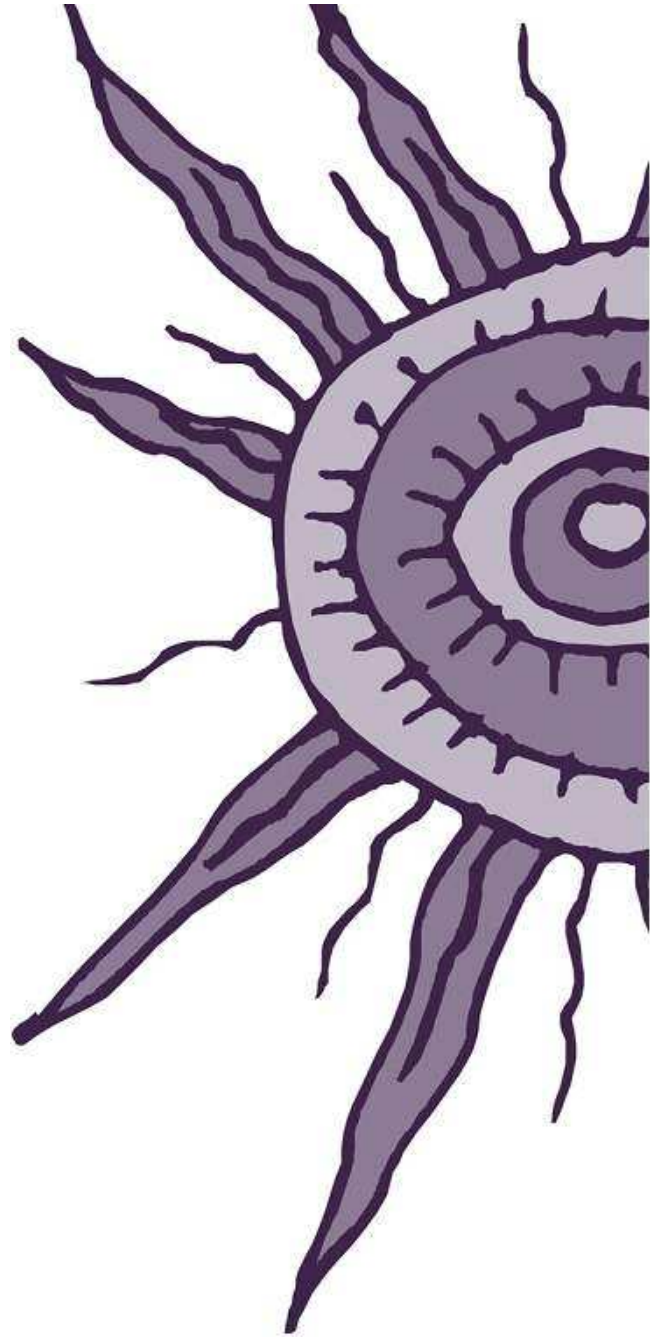


Guide to Coping with Redundancy

INTRODUCTION

This guide has been produced by the Harlow Rapid Response Group, a partnership led by Harlow Council, and including Harlow College, Jobcentre Plus, Harlow Welfare Rights & Advice Service, Adult Community College, East of England Development Agency, Harlow Co-operative Development Agency.

The group was set up to provide a co-ordinated support service to Harlow companies and workers facing a redundancy situation and has assisted many companies and their workforces over the last four years. Help we can provide includes free copies of this guide, advice and support with managing job losses, helping workers move into alternative employment and/or training, and help in accessing funds for training.

The guide is intended for both workers and companies to help find the various organisations and agencies that can provide advice, support and guidance when faced with a redundancy situation. Included in the guide are agencies that can offer:

- **advice** on employment law rights and responsibilities, social security benefits, tax credits and debt advice
- **recruitment and job search** assistance
- **learning and training** opportunities and career guidance
- **company support** for businesses in the process of making redundancies and business restructuring
- **business start-up** advice for people considering self-employment

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

When faced with a redundancy situation there are a number of requirements that an employer has to meet to ensure that the redundancy has been dealt with in the right way.

Employers are obliged by law to inform and consult employee representatives over planned collective redundancies and transfers of undertakings.

Employees have the right to be kept informed and up to date with regards to a redundancy situation as well as time off work to look for further employment and if you are eligible, a redundancy payment.

KEY TO SYMBOLS

INFORMATION AND ADVICE



Redundancy occurs when your job no longer exists or when there has been a reduction in work and your employer needs to cut staff. If you are dismissed by reason of redundancy, you have certain rights. The redundancy guide gives details of organisations with trained staff that can provide a range of information on your redundancy rights. Also included are organisations that can give advice on social security benefits, tax, debt, and other sources of help and advice to enable you to get back into the labour market.

LEARNING AND TRAINING



If you are facing redundancy you may wish to consider training and/or retraining. There are many local courses which offer the opportunity for you to learn new skills, update your existing skills or gain recognised qualifications for the skills you have already built up in your working life, there are a variety of different organisations throughout Harlow that can help with learning and training, as well as a number of national training bodies.

RECRUITMENT AGENCIES



Listed are recruitment agencies with local offices that can assist you in looking for job opportunities in a variety of fields. Some can also assist with training and other support to help you return to work. They can provide both part and full time temporary as well as permanent positions within a variety of sectors.

COMPANY SUPPORT
