Mike White, head of Harlow Council's Legal Department and Democratic Services, formally announced the results.

Bharat, Chloe, Daniel, Doris, Jack, Jasmin, Jennie, Joshua, Kinjal, Matt, Megan, Sean and Zoë were elected on to Harlow Youth Council. They will join the existing second year youth councillors and Young Essex Assembly members to form the Harlow Youth Council for 2008.

Total number of votes cast was 3,646. Based on 2001 Census information (approx 9,097 11-19 year-olds) the turnout was 40%. Some 3,395 votes were made in secondary schools.

Reserve youth councillors will have the opportunity to attend all full youth council meetings and participate in training with the elected youth councillors. They can also be involved with the Cafe Youth Management Group or Harlow YouthBank.
