Current Capital Scheme Appraisal Process

1. All capital project bids are managed centrally by the Council's Assets and Facilities Management Service. Each project is assessed and awarded factor points by officers of the Capital Project Group based on the project's ability to meet the Council's aims and objectives as set out in a range of key corporate documents.
2. The assessment criteria are:
 - contribution to Community Strategy
 - contribution to Statement of Intent
 - contribution to BVPP
 - contribution to Service Plans
 - other (including impact on revenue).
3. The assessment is then reported to the Strategic Capital Group comprising, amongst others, the Executive Directors for Resources and Housing and the Head of Assets and Facilities Management.
4. Following approval the project bids are considered by the Policy and Resources Committee.
