



Work Starts on Skate Park 20th November 2007



Youth Councillor Tara represents Harlow Youth Council and the young people of Harlow at a ceremonial "first dig" of the town's new state-of-the-art skate park.

The skate park is scheduled to be finished towards the end of March 2008; it will cover 808sq. metres, will be fully floodlit and be 100% covered by CCTV cameras.

The park, located in the Town Park between Harlow Pool and Burnt Mill School, will replace the existing wooden skating facility, which was only intended to be temporary.

Features will include a concrete bowl, kinked handrails, a number of box rails and a coffin-shaped box in the centre. They will all be created using a smooth moulded concrete that will be long-lasting and quiet to skate on.
