Endorsement of Photograph

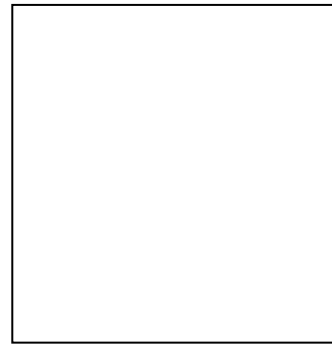
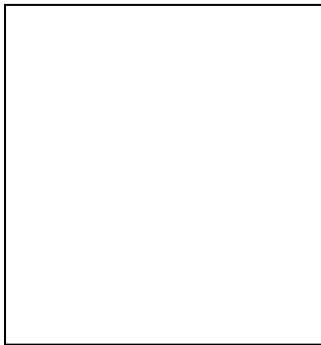
Obtain two recent passport size photographs, which shall be—

- (i) taken against a light background so that the applicant's features are distinguishable and contrast against the background,
- (ii) 45 millimetres by 35 millimetres,
- (iii) full face uncovered and without sunglasses and, unless the applicant wears a head covering due to his religious beliefs, without a head covering,
- (iv) on photographic paper, and

The back of one of the photographs must be endorsed with the words **“I certify that this is a true likeness of (insert applicant full name)”** and signed by a solicitor or notary, a person of standing in the community or any individual with a professional qualification. A person of standing in the community includes: a bank or building society official, a police officer, a civil servant or a minister of religion.
