

Licensing Act 2003

Information Sheet – Fees

Premises Licences and Club Premises Certificates

Each premises that is licensable will be allocated to a fee band according to rateable value. If the premises are part of a larger property with one overall rateable value, the fee is calculated on that rateable value. If the premises extend over two or more units, then the fee is based on the highest rateable value.

Each band attracts a different level of application/variation fee. Each band attracts a different level of annual fee – payable one year after the grant of the licence. This fee will also be based on the rateable value and Licence holders will be sent an invoice automatically.

A multiplier is applied to premises in bands D and E where they are exclusively or primarily in the business of selling alcohol.

Where the maximum number of persons the applicant proposes should, during the times when the licence authorises licensable activities to take place on the premises, be allowed on the premises at the same time is 5,000 or more, the application must be accompanied by an additional fee.

There are some **exemptions to the fees** in relation to church halls, village halls, parish halls and other similar community buildings. These apply where the licence is for regulated entertainment only and does not involve the sale or supply of alcohol.

Some educational establishments are also exempt from paying the fees:

- 1. where the licence is for regulated entertainment only;
- 2. the holder of the licence is to be the proprietor of a school or college;
- 3. the premises are, or form part of, the educational institution; and
- 4. the provision of regulated entertainment is carried on by the school or college for and on behalf of the purposes of the educational institution.
