Redundancy & the Law

When faced with a redundancy situation there are a number of legal requirements that an employer has to meet to ensure that the redundancy has been dealt with in the right way.

Employers are obliged by law to inform and consult employee representatives over planned collective redundancies and transfers of undertakings. Employers can seek advice from the Department of Business Innovation and Skills (BIS), ACAS, employer organisations or solicitors.

Employees have the right to be kept informed and up to date with regards to a redundancy situation as well as time off work to look for further employment and if you are eligible, a redundancy payment.

Redundancy Guide Sections

INFORMATION AND ADVICE



Redundancy occurs when your job no longer exists or when there has been a reduction in work and your employer needs to cut staff. If you are dismissed by reason of redundancy, you have certain rights. The redundancy guide gives details of organisations with trained staff that can provide a range of information on your redundancy rights. Also included are organisations that can give advice on social security benefits, tax, debt, and other sources of help and advice to enable you to get back into the labour market.

EMPLOYMENT & SUPPORT AGENCIES



Listed are recruitment agencies with local offices that can assist you in looking for job opportunities in a variety of fields. Some can also assist with training and other support to help you return to work. They can provide both part and full time temporary as well as permanent positions within a variety of sectors.

LEARNING AND TRAINING



If you are facing redundancy you may wish to consider training and/or retraining. There are many local courses which offer the opportunity for you to learn new skills, update your existing skills or gain recognised qualifications for the skills you have already built up in your working life.
