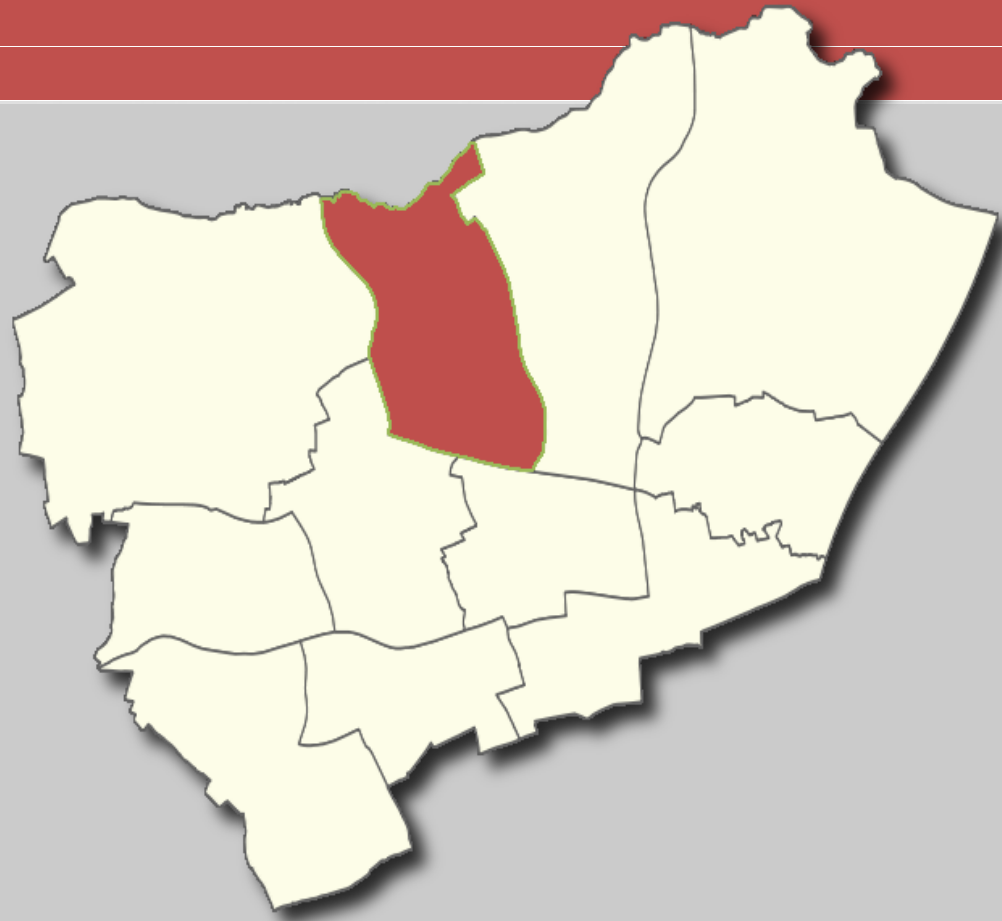


Netteswell



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Key Facts

Netteswell has a population of 7423, making it Harlow's fourth most populated ward.

The average age of its residents is 39 years, just above the Harlow average.

The predominant ethnic group is White: British with 80% of the population.

38% of residents rent their dwelling from the council, one of the highest such proportions in Harlow.

Netteswell has the lowest proportion of residents that own their dwelling.

Population

Netteswell has a population of 7423, making it the fourth least populated ward in Harlow, housing less than 9% of the Town's residents. It has a male/female ratio of 48:52, which is broadly in line with the Harlow average.

Trends & Comparisons

In the decade 2001 to 2011, Netteswell's population increased by 5.5%, from 7038 to 7423. Above the 4% growth experienced by Harlow as a whole. This above average growth saw Netteswell move from the 8th most populated ward in 2001 to the 5th in 2011.

Age Distribution

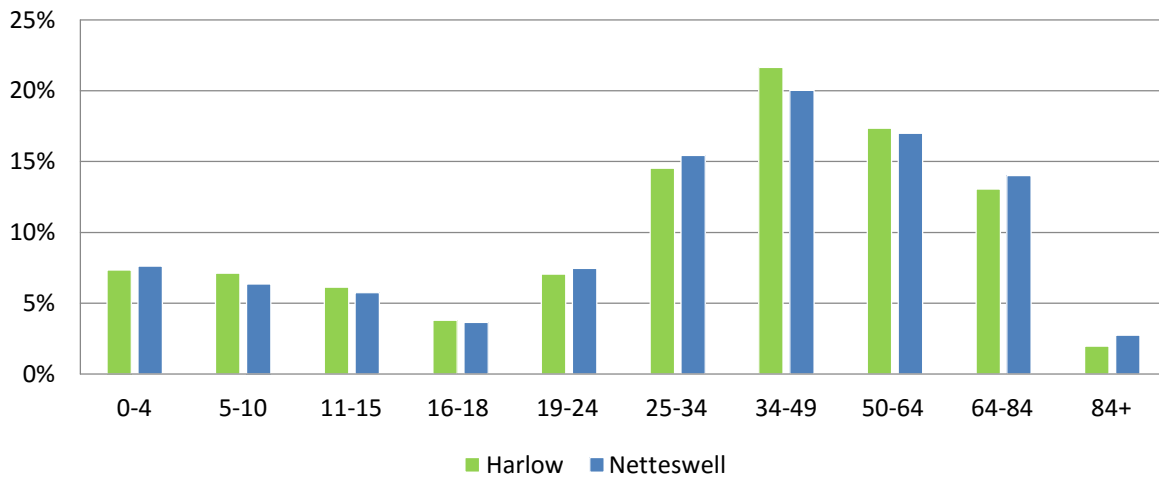
Netteswell's population has an average age of 39 years, close to the Town average of 38 years.

The predominant age bands are 0-4 and 25-29, yet the ward has a higher proportion of residents aged 64 years and over than Harlow as a whole.

QS103EW – Age by single year

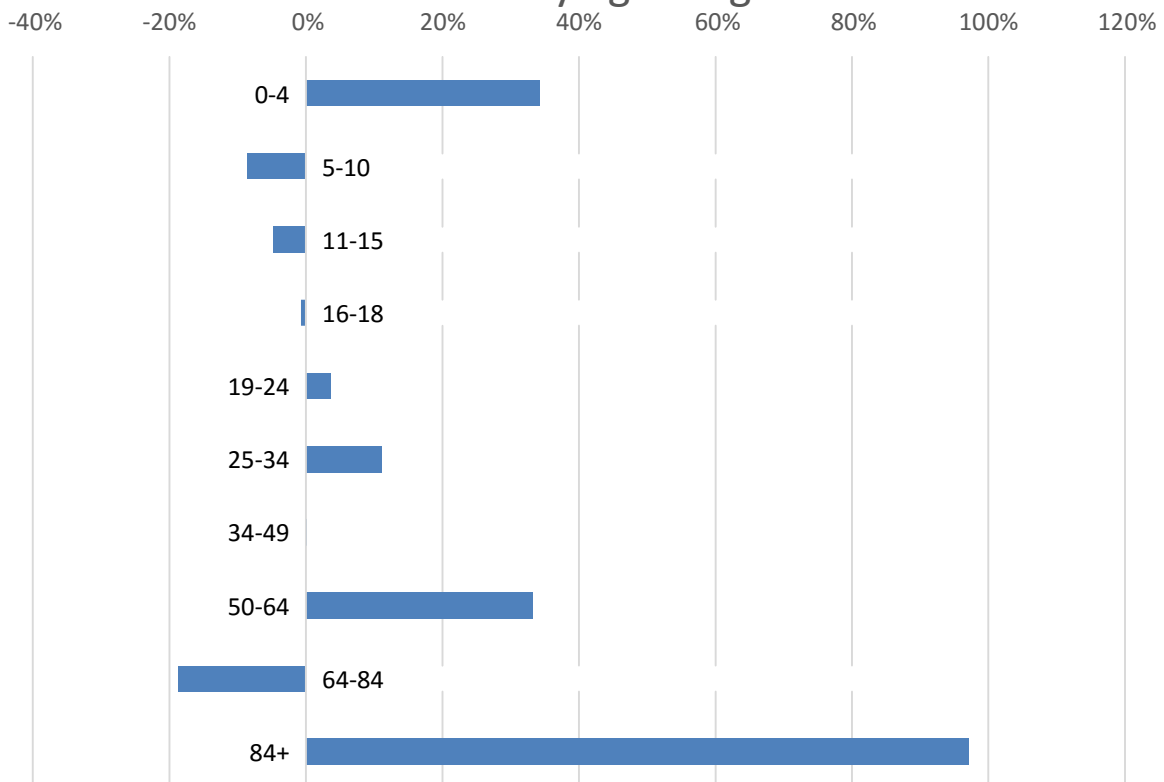
Age distribution compared to Harlow

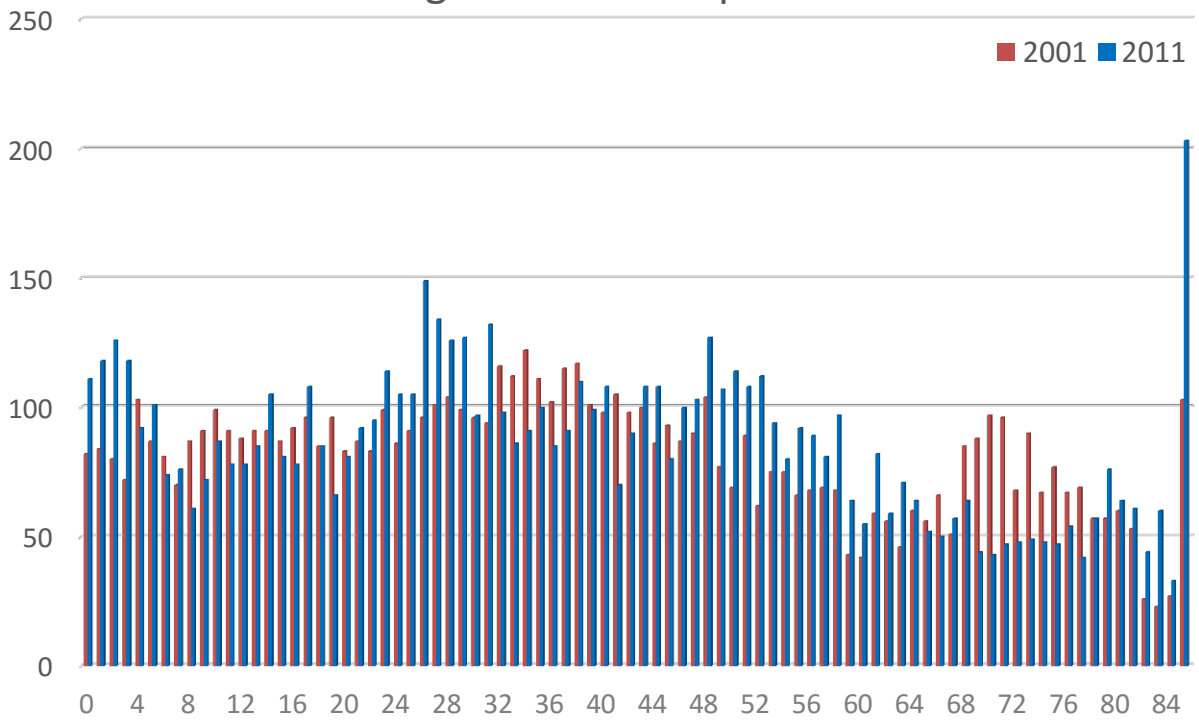
In the decade 2001-2011 the average age of Netteswell's residents remained at 39 years. The average age of residents Town wide increased from 37 to 38 years.

Age distribution profiles



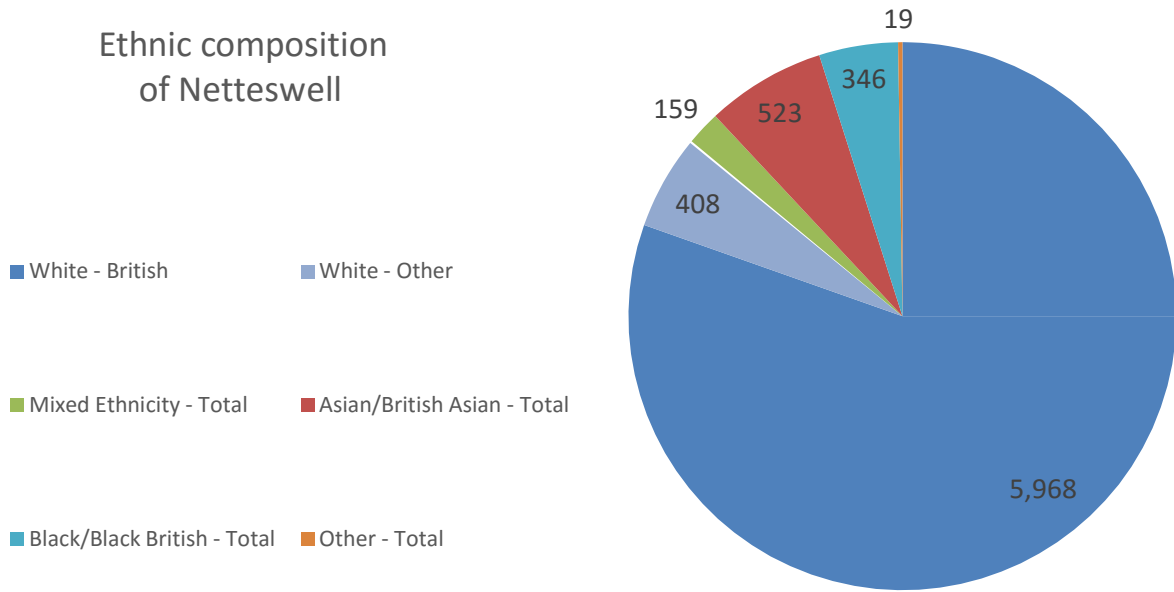
Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group in Netteswell is *White: British*, comprising of over 80% of the ward's population. The second largest ethnic group is Asian/Asian – British, making up more than 7% of the total population. *White - Other* is another significant subset, making up almost 5.5% of the ward's population.

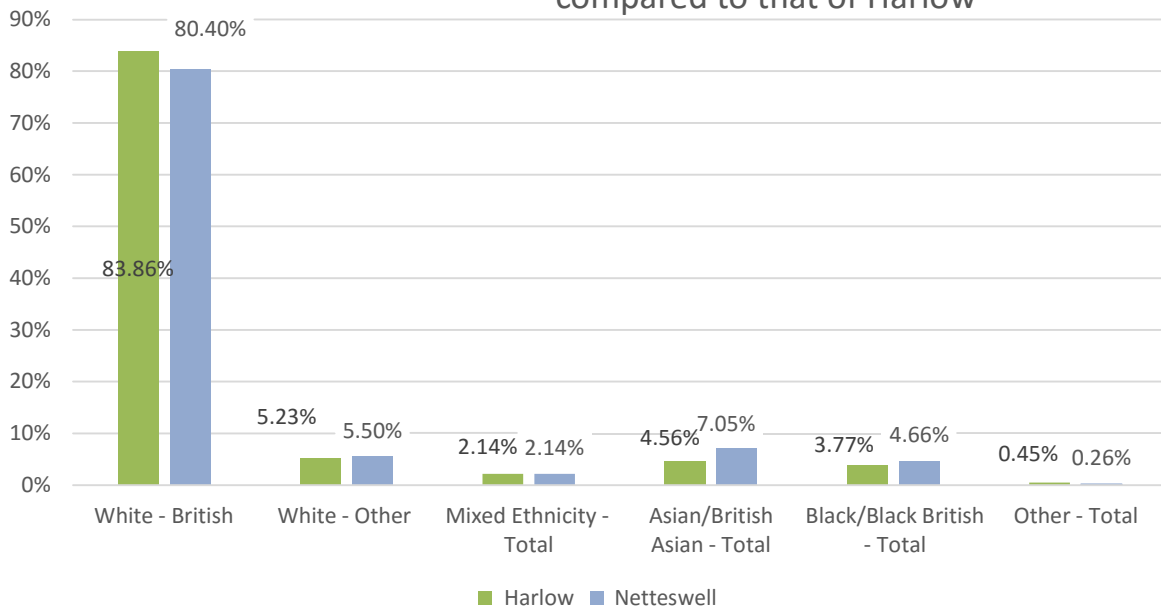
Ethnic composition of Netteswell



In Comparison to Harlow

Netteswell’s proportion of *White – British* residents is lower than that of Harlow as a whole. Its proportion of *Asian/Asian British* residents is above the town average and is the second largest population of *Asian/Asian British* residents of any ward in Harlow.

Netteswell's ethnic composition compared to that of Harlow

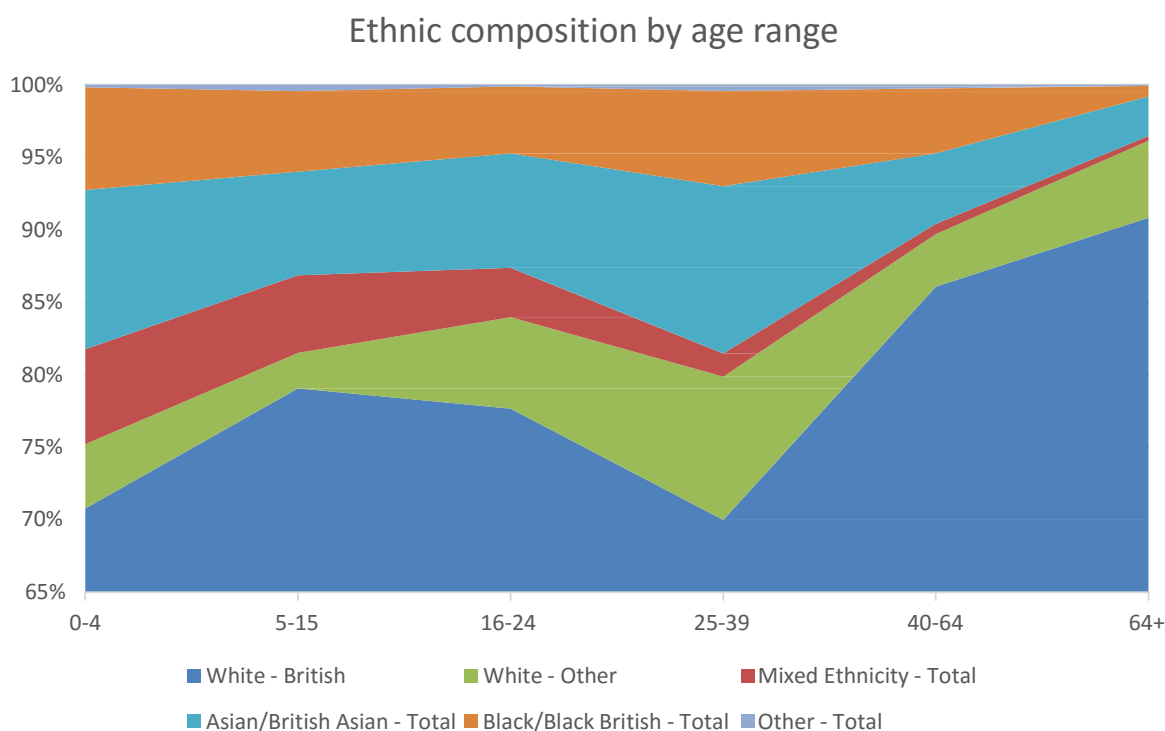


Ethnicity by Age

White British is the predominant ethnic group in each age range for Netteswell. However the proportion of each ethnic group varies significantly through the age bands, as seen in the proportional area graph below.

Of the population aged 0 to 4 years of age, the proportion of *White British* residents is less than 71%, whilst for the population aged 64 and above, the proportion rises to 91%.

Almost 11% of residents under 5 years of age are of *Asian/Asian British* ethnicity. The second largest proportion of that demographic in all wards in Harlow.



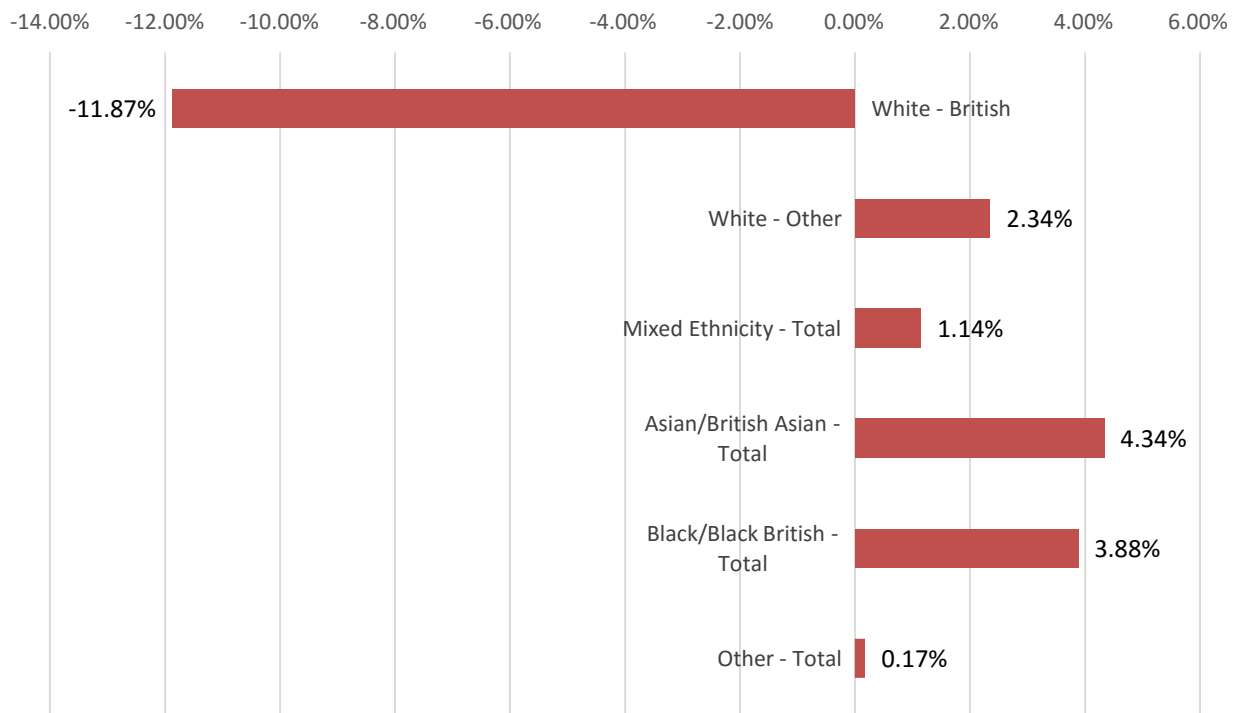

Nationalities

85% of Netteswell's population were born in the United Kingdom, below the Town average of 88%.

Over 4% of the ward's population come from countries in Southern Asia. They account for 28% of the ward's non-UK nationals.

The next likeliest area of origin is countries admitted to the EU since 2001, where almost 3% of the ward originate.

Trends

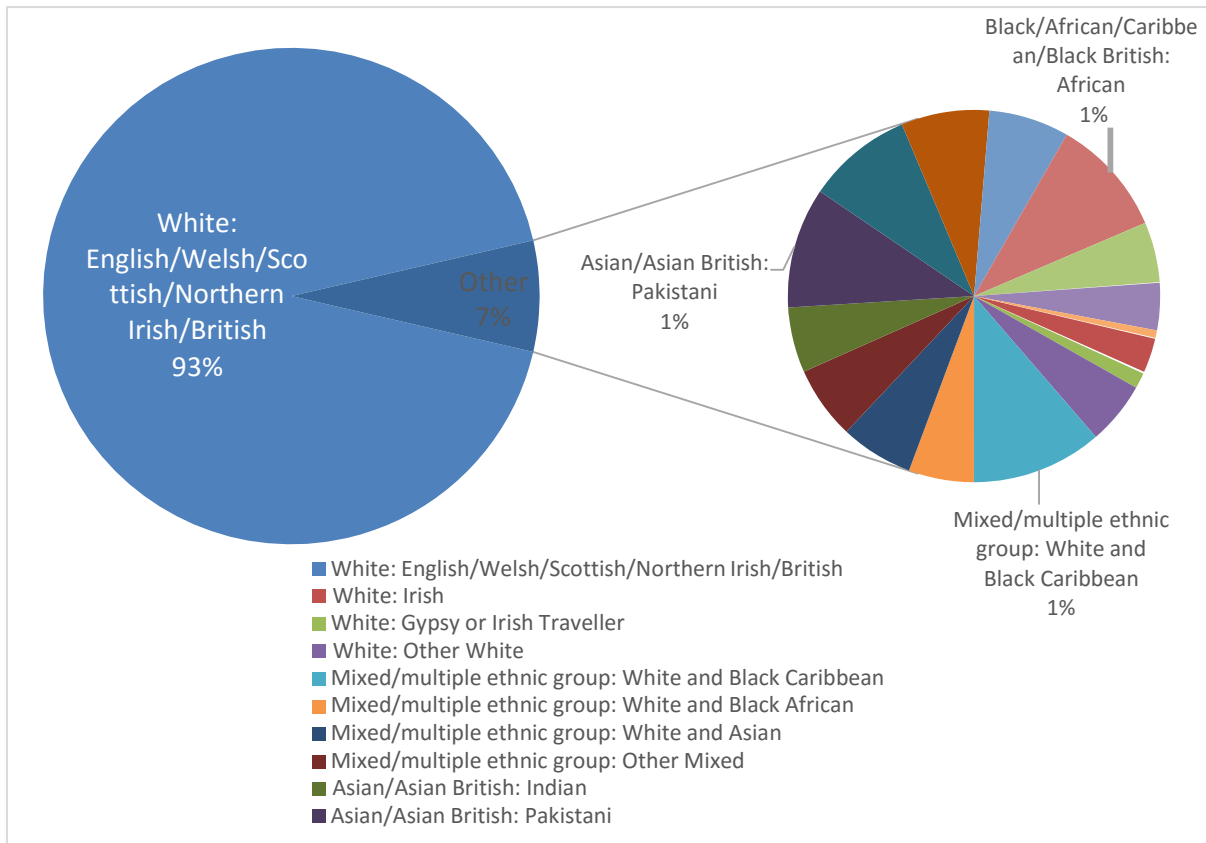
Like all but two wards in Harlow, Netteswell saw its population of residents born in the United Kingdom fall in real terms and in proportion during the decade 2001-2011.

The decade also saw significant growth in the populations of people from countries recently admitted to the EU and from Southern Asia.

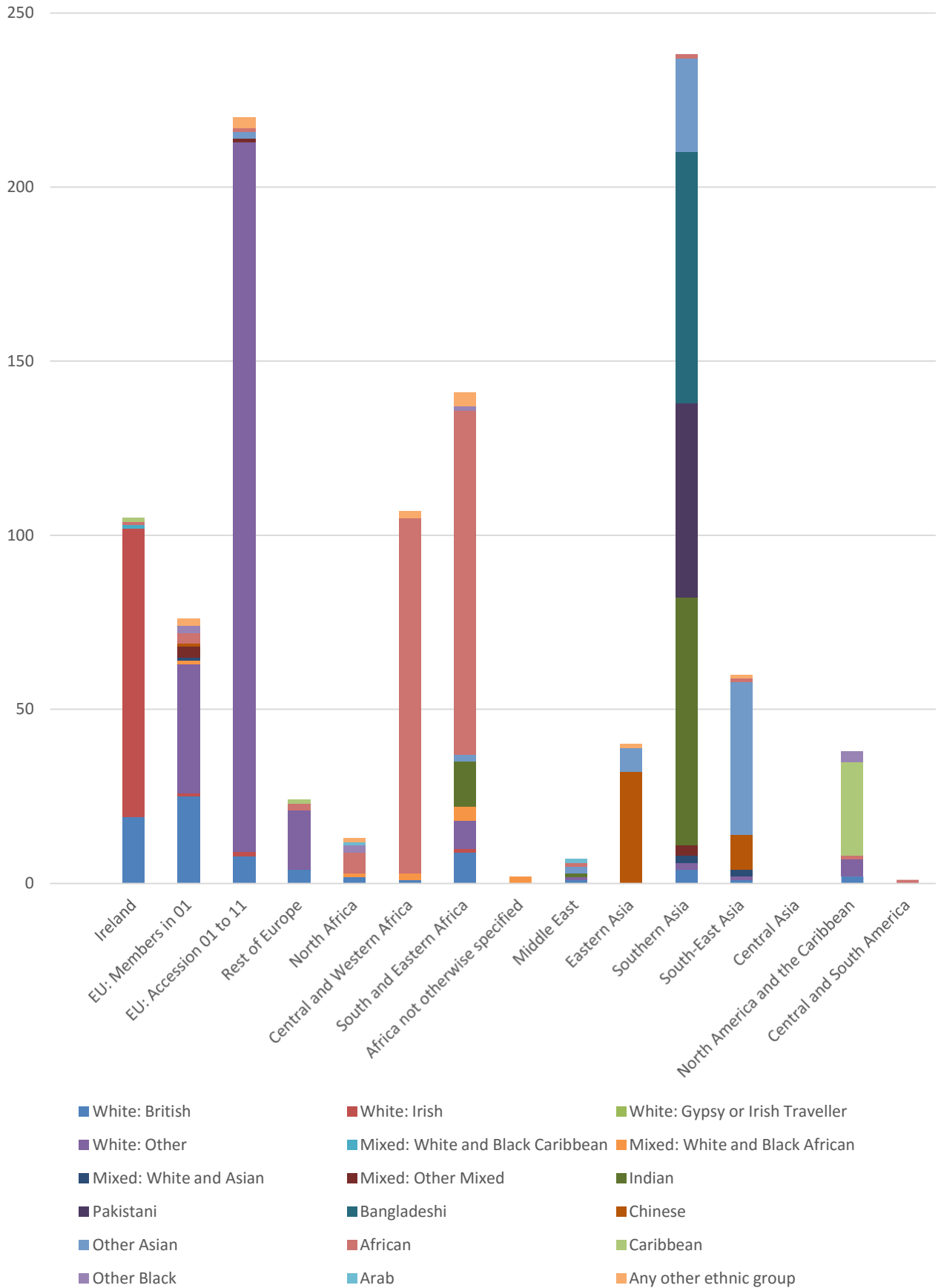

Ethnic composition of Netteswell's nationalities (excluding UK)



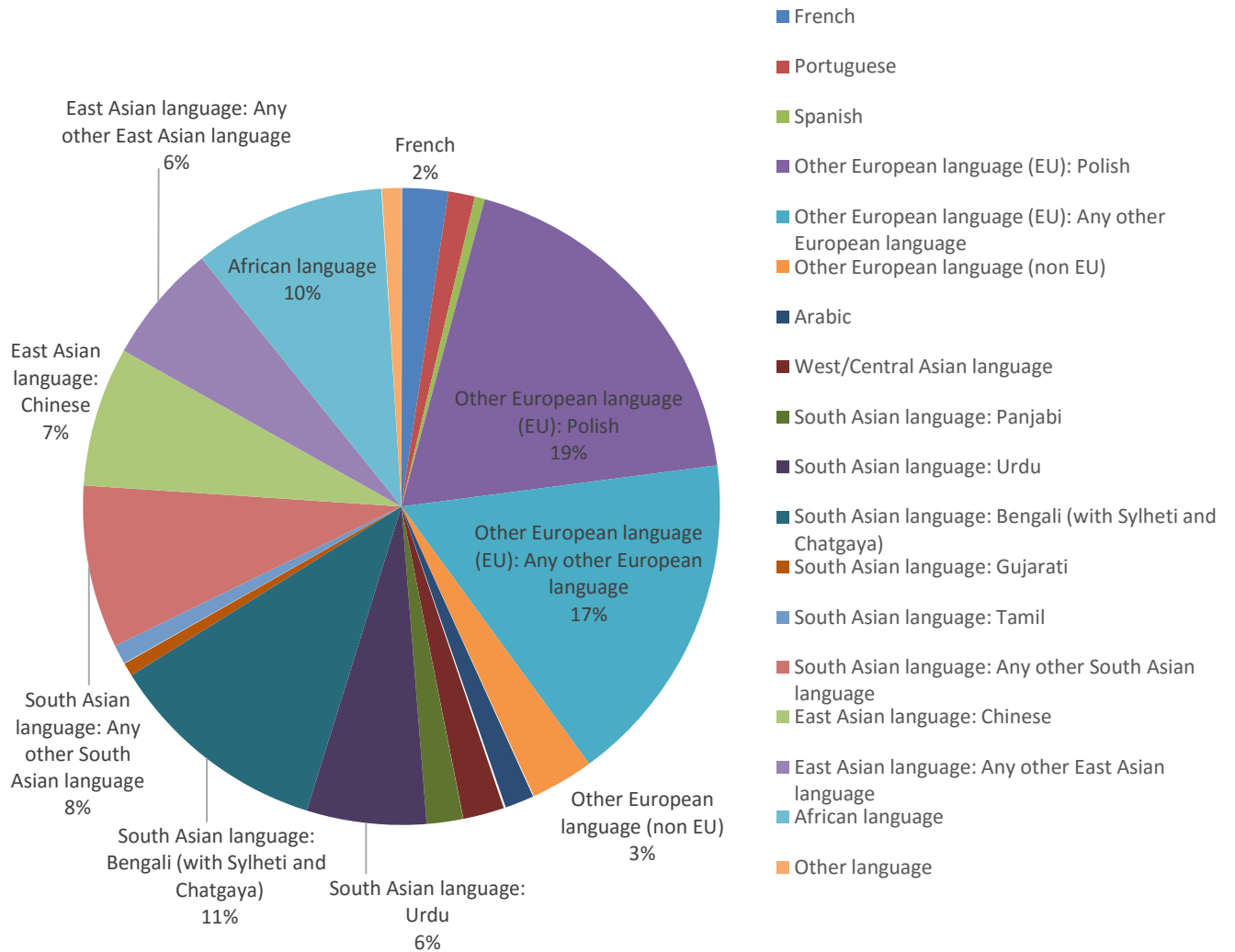

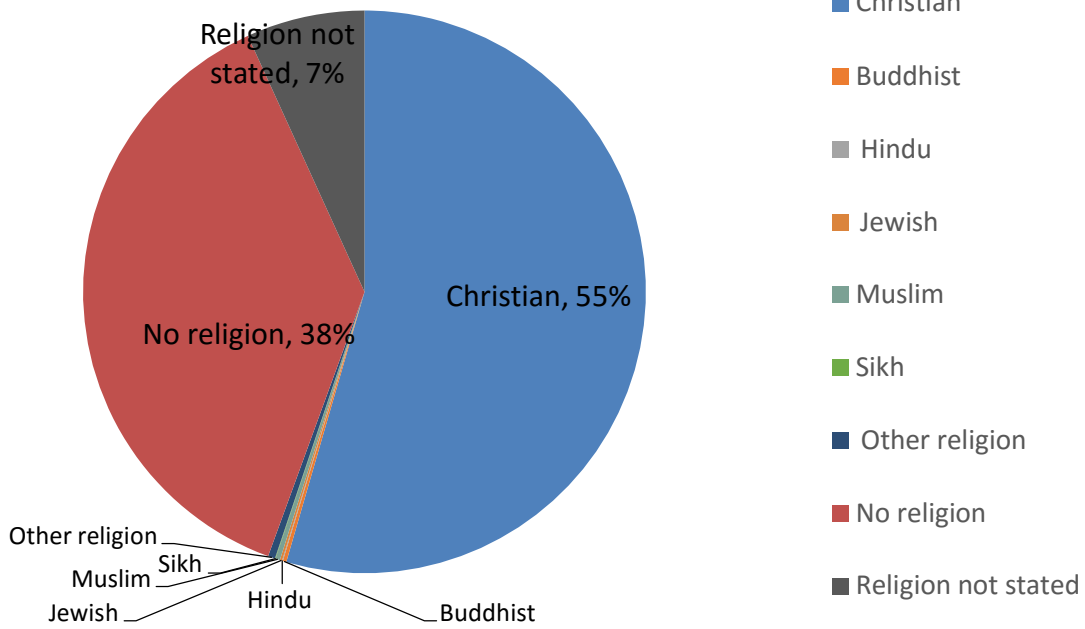

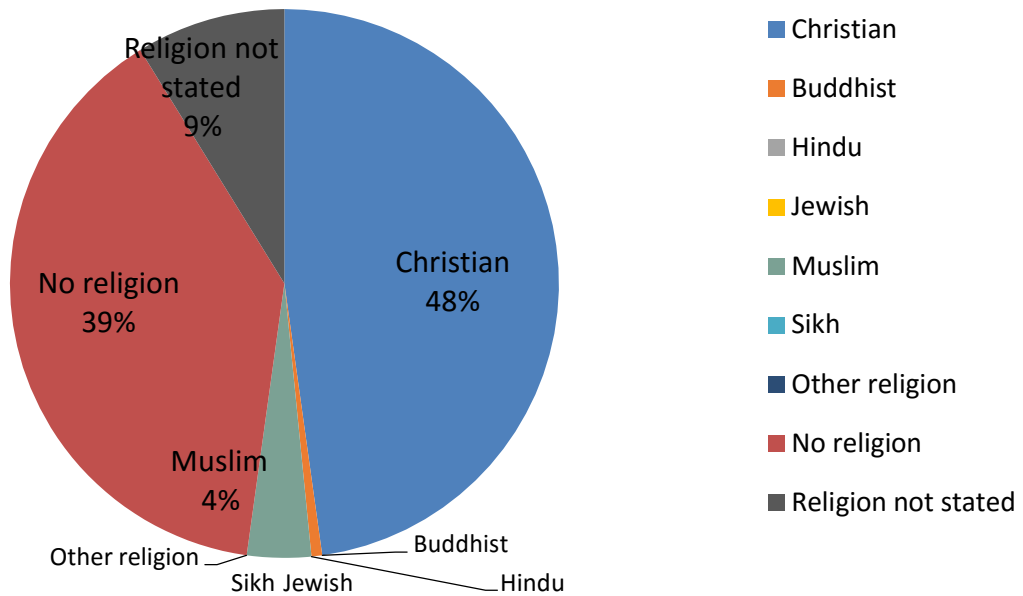
Since 2001 the number of Christians in Netteswell has fallen by almost 16%. This is a faster rate of decline than in Harlow overall, which saw the number of Christians decrease by over 14%. At the start of the decade approximately 22% of residents in Netteswell described themselves as having No Religion. By 2011 this proportion had risen to 34%.

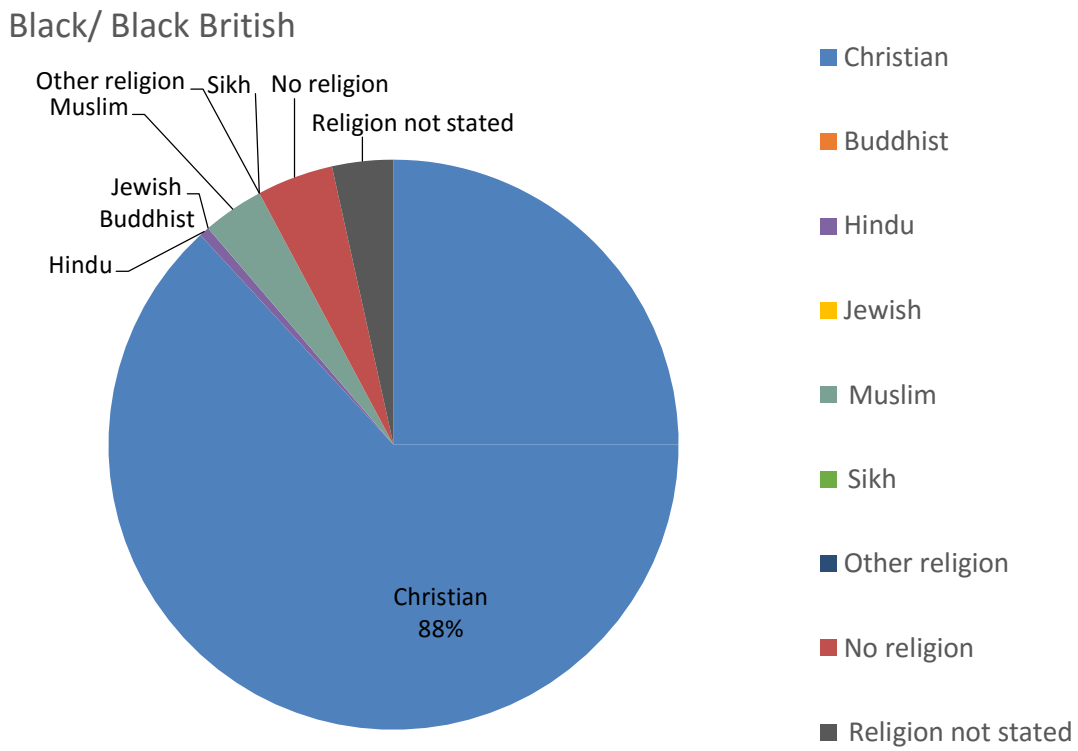
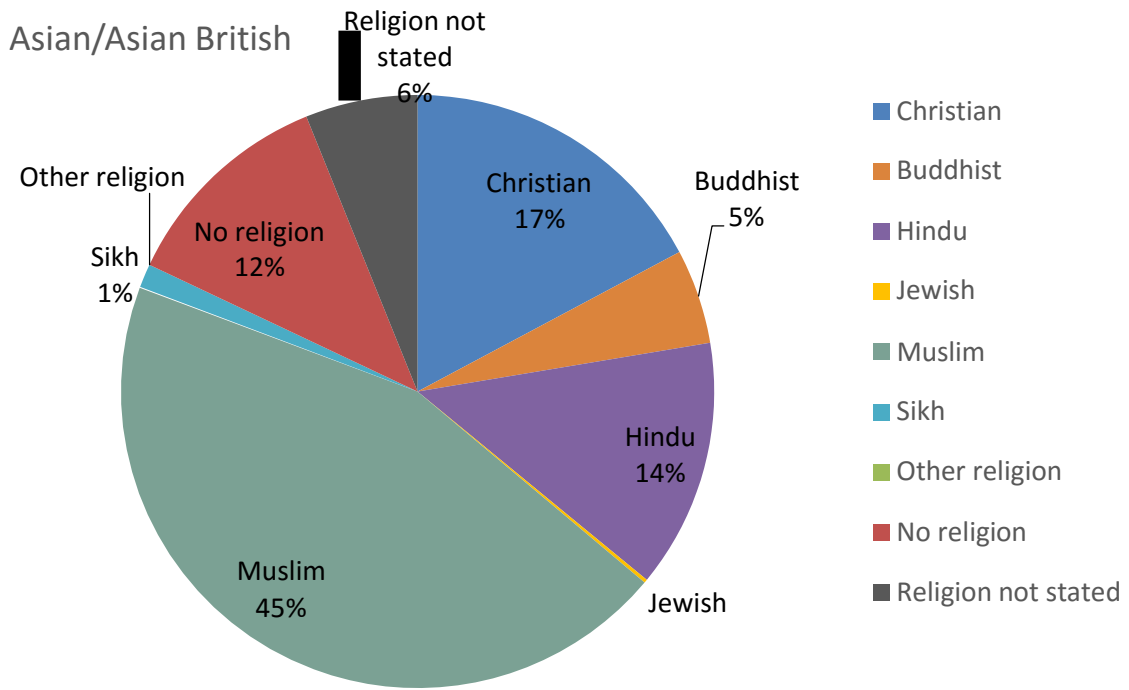

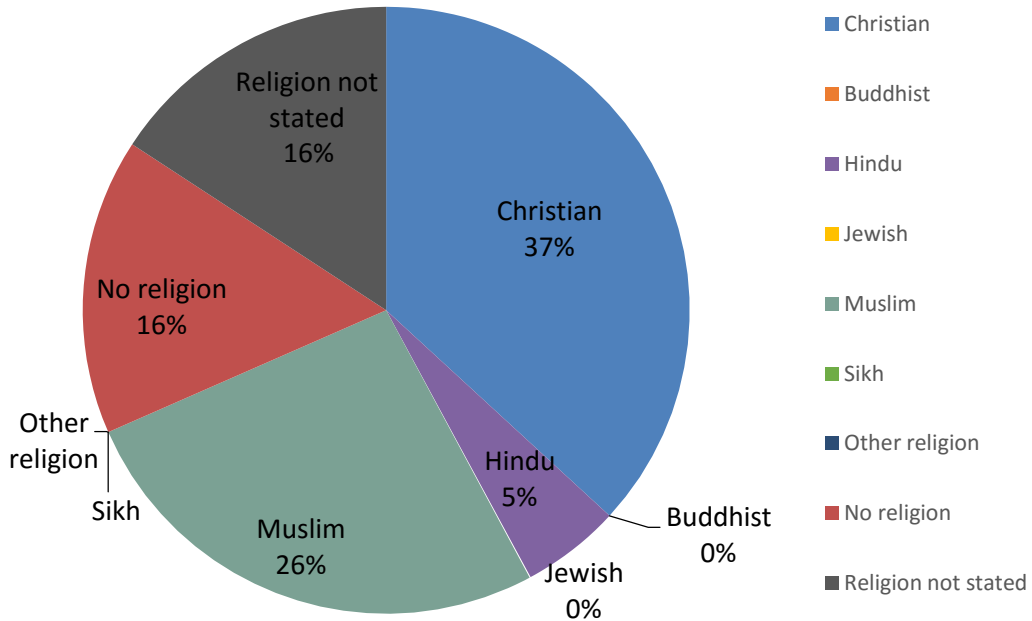


Mixed Ethnicity

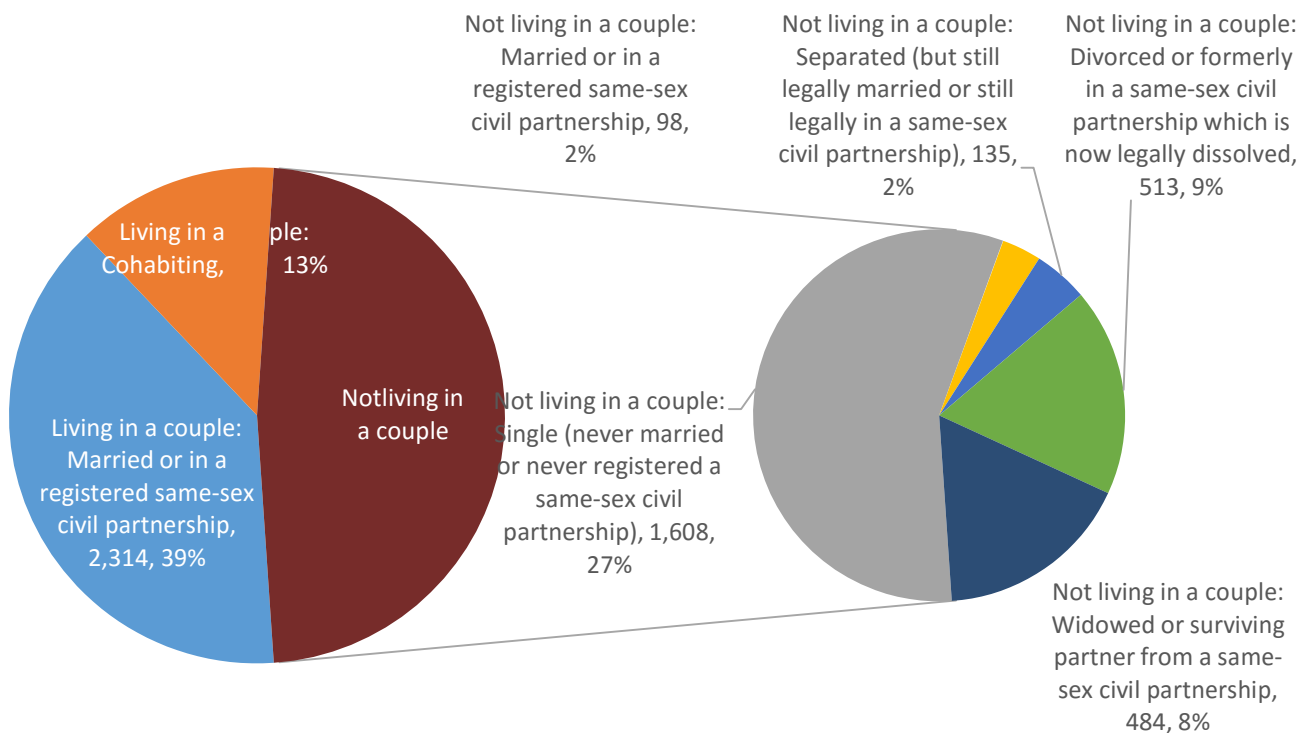

Of Netteswell's residents aged 16 and over, 52% are living as a couple; the majority of whom are either married or living in a civil partnership.

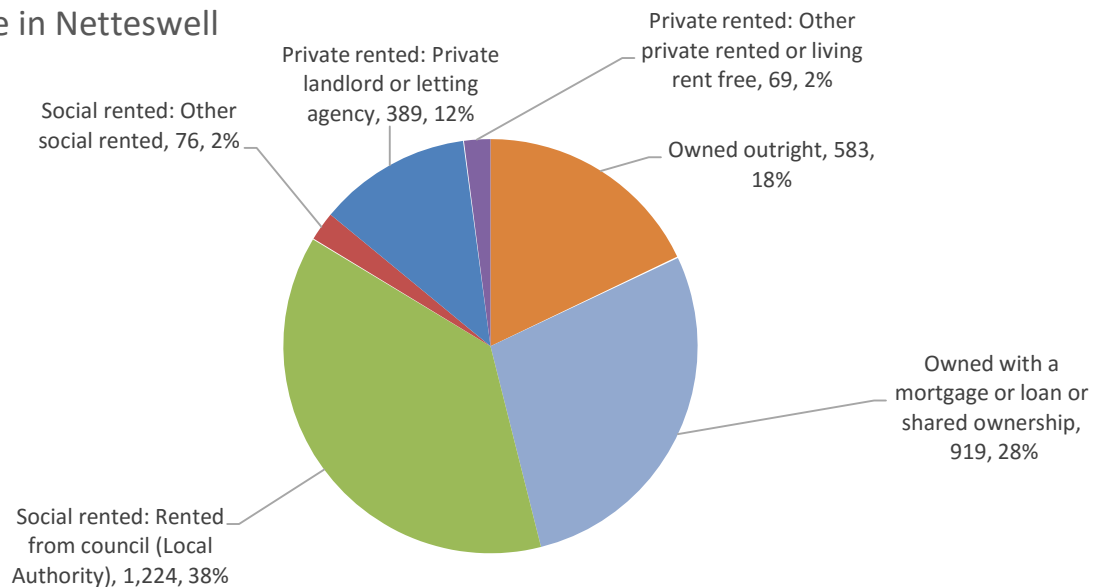


Tenure

Of Netteswell’s 3260 households, 46% of properties are either owned outright or owned with a mortgage or loan. The lowest proportion of ownership of all wards and significantly lower than Harlow overall, where 57% of residents own their dwelling.

Netteswell also has a high ratio of social tenure. Notably those renting from the council accounts for 38% of all households, whereas across Harlow 27% of all dwellings are rented from the council.

As expected, ownership varies greatly across the various ages bands. Amongst residents aged 16-34 only 2% own their dwelling outright and only 29% own with a mortgage or through shared ownership. For residents over 64 years of age, 52% own their dwellings of which 44% own them outright.

Qualifications

Netteswell's levels of education are slightly lower than those of Harlow overall. 15% of residents over 16 have achieved Level 4 qualifications or above compared to 18% in the Town as a whole.

Likewise, 29% of Netteswell's residents have no qualifications compared to 26% across Harlow.

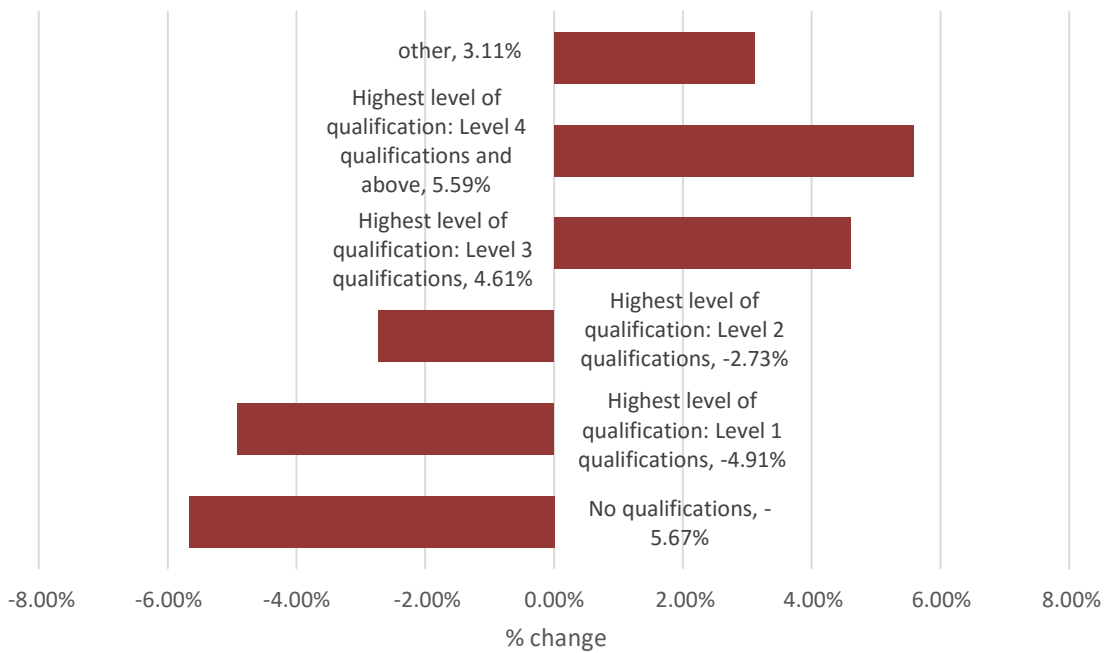

Trends

During the decade 2001 to 2011 there was a significant decrease in the proportion of Harlow's population who held no qualifications, with an average proportional decline of approximately 6%. This was mirrored in Netteswell where the proportion of residents without qualifications also fell by 6%.

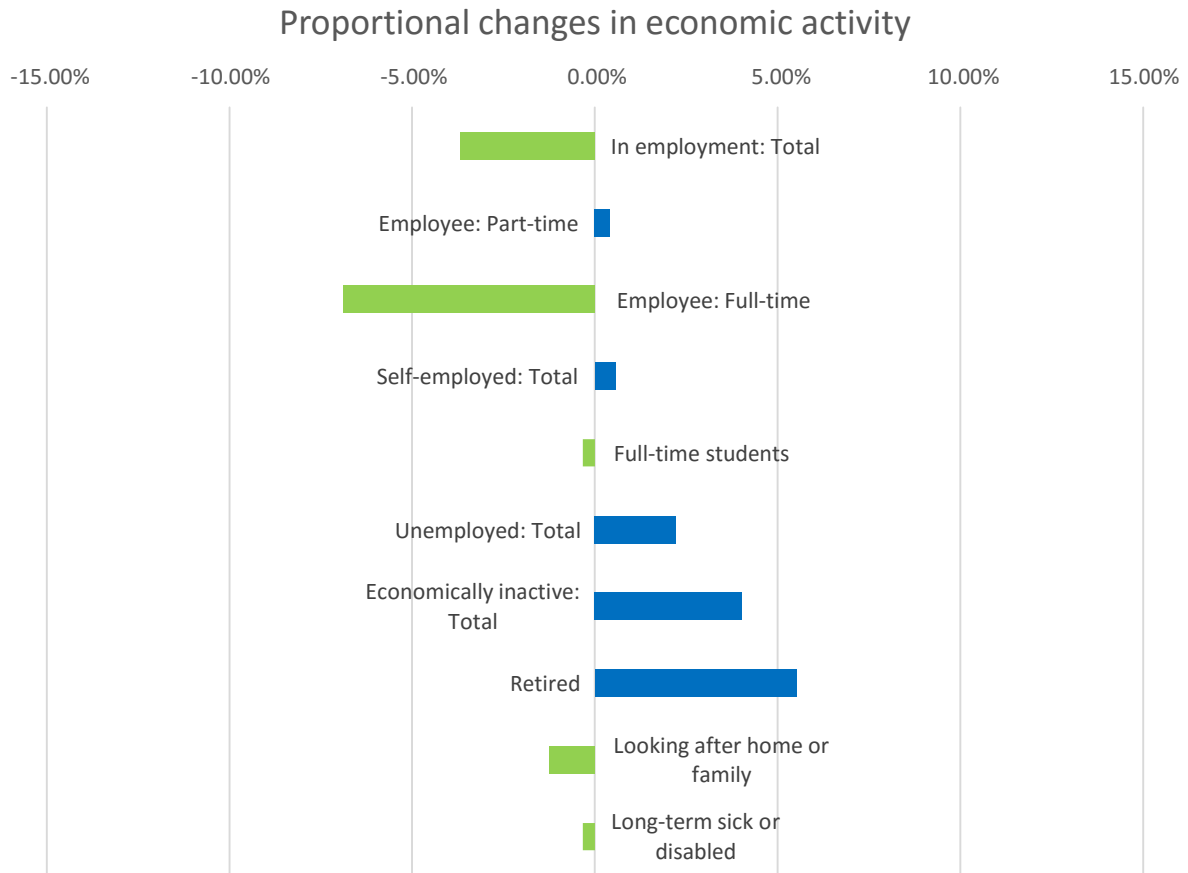

Trends

In the decade 2001 to 2011 the proportion of people in employment fell, as it did in all but one other ward in Harlow. The number of residents who are economically active and unemployed has increased from 200 to 368 during those 10 years.

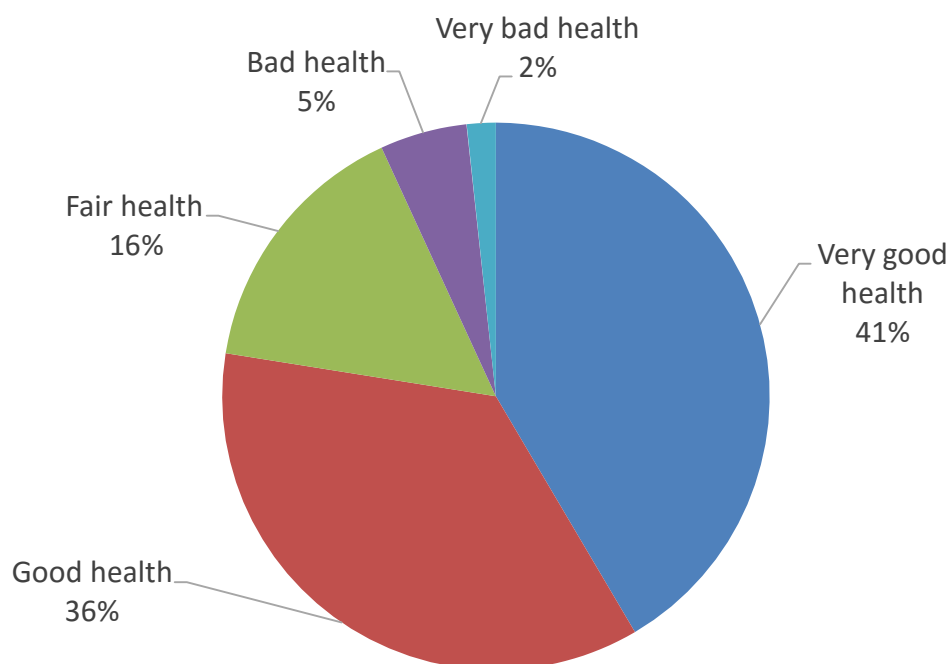
Disability and Health

Health in Netteswell



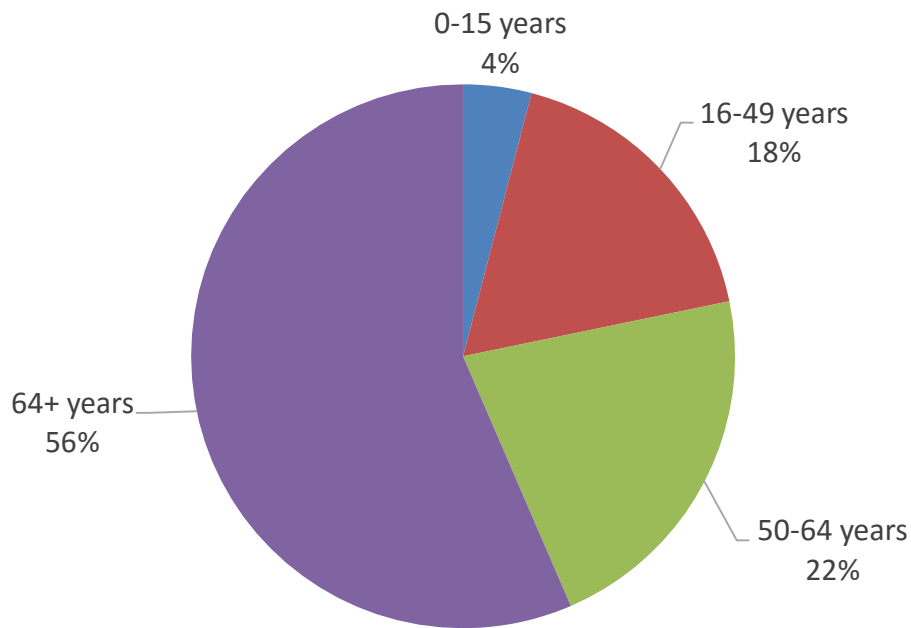

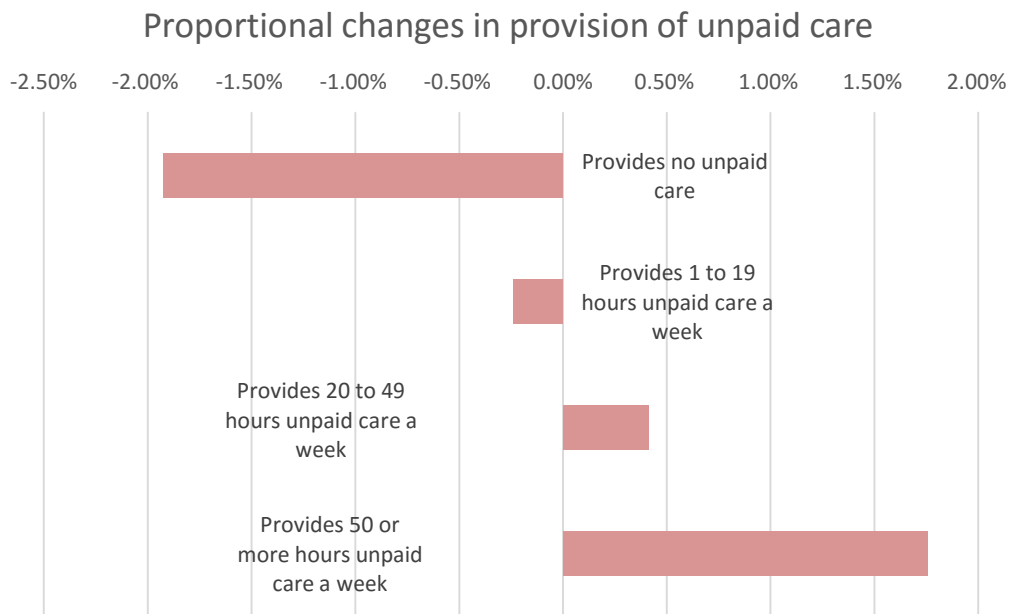
