

# Toddbrook



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## Key Facts

Toddbrook is Harlow's fourth most populated ward with 7544 residents.

The average age of its residents is 39 years.

The predominant ethnic group is White: British with 80% of the population.

Toddbrook has the second largest proportion of people who do not speak English as a main language.

34% of households consist of one person only, the second highest such proportion in Harlow.

# Population

Toddbrook has a population of 7544, making it the fourth most populated ward in Harlow, housing over 9% of the Town's residents. It has a male/female ratio of 48:52, which is in line with the Harlow average.

## Trends & Comparisons

In the decade 2001 to 2011, Toddbrook's population increased by 4.6% from 7212 to 7544, the fifth fastest growth rate in the town and above the 4% growth experienced by Harlow as a whole.

This above average growth saw Toddbrook move from the town's seventh most populated ward in 2001 to the fourth in 2011.

# Age Distribution

Toddbrook’s population has an average age of almost 39 years, slightly above the Town average of 38 years.

The predominant age bands are 25-29 and 30-34. Toddbrook also has a greater proportion of residents aged over 84 years than the Town as a whole.

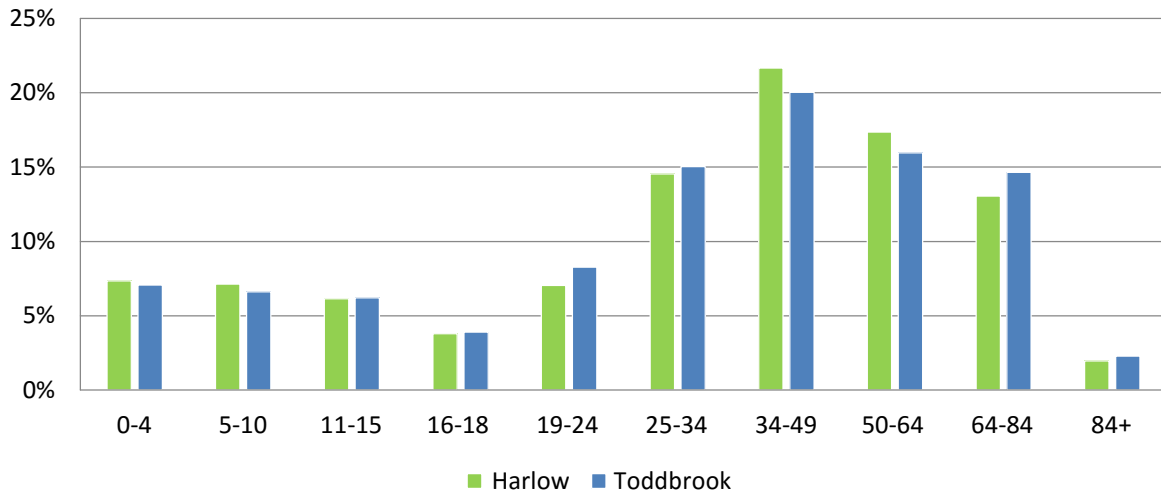

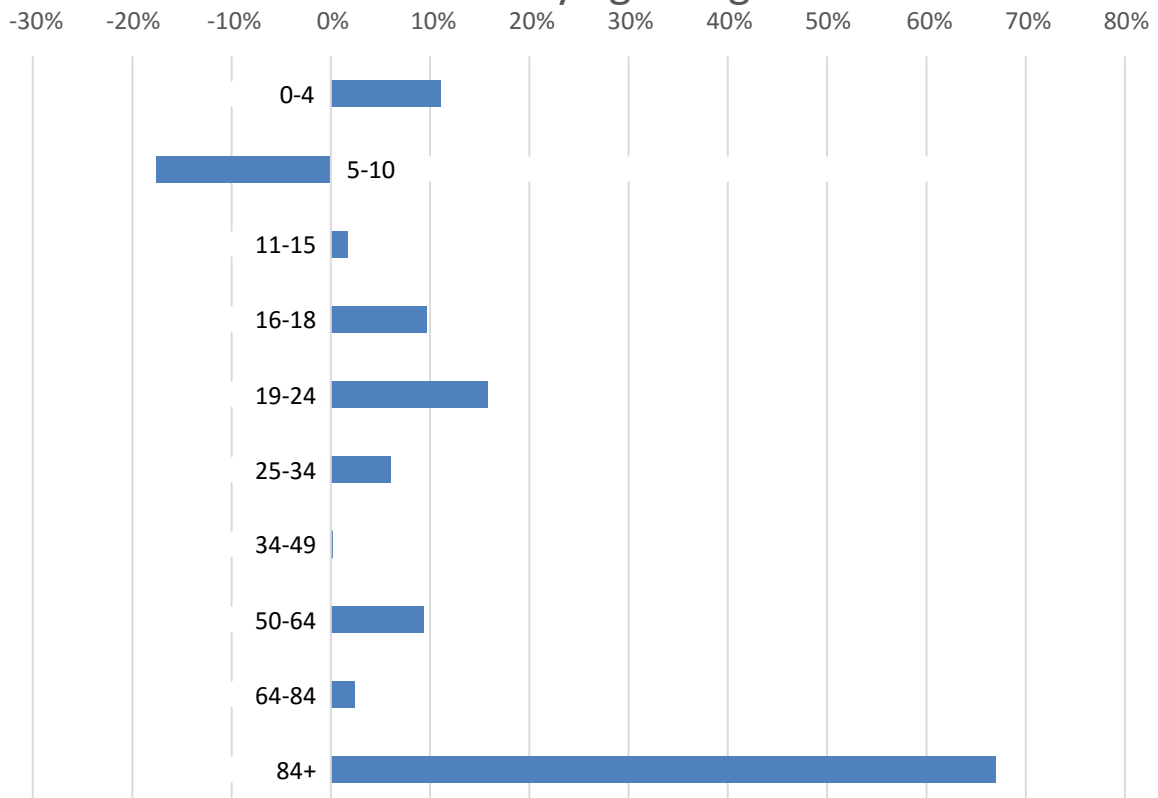
## Trends

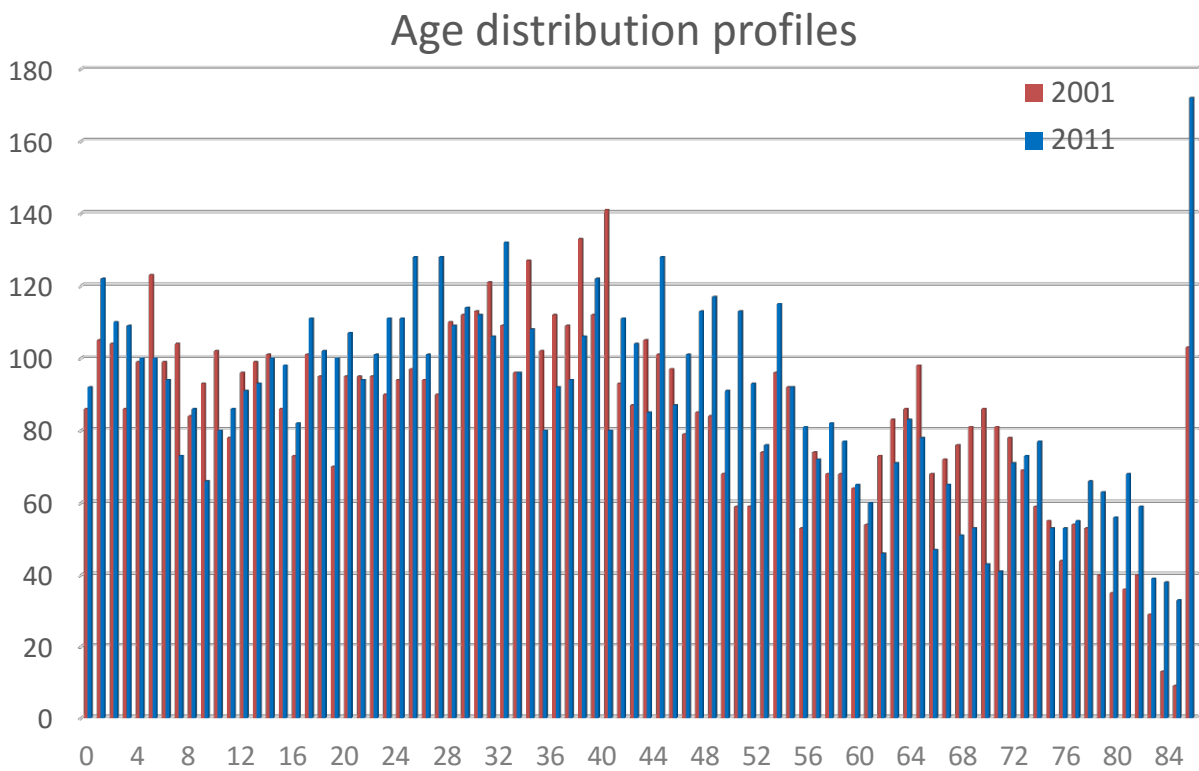
### Age distribution compared to Harlow

As with almost all wards and it was the age group of those over 84 years that experienced the fastest rate of growth.



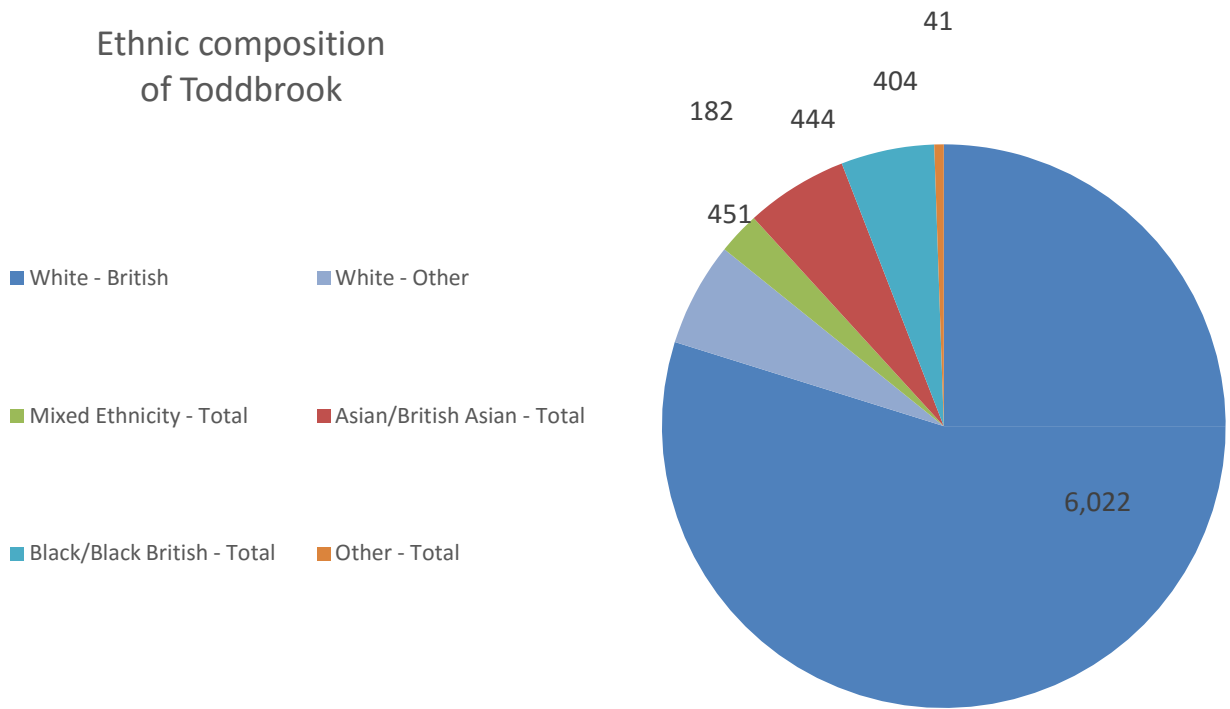
# Ethnicity

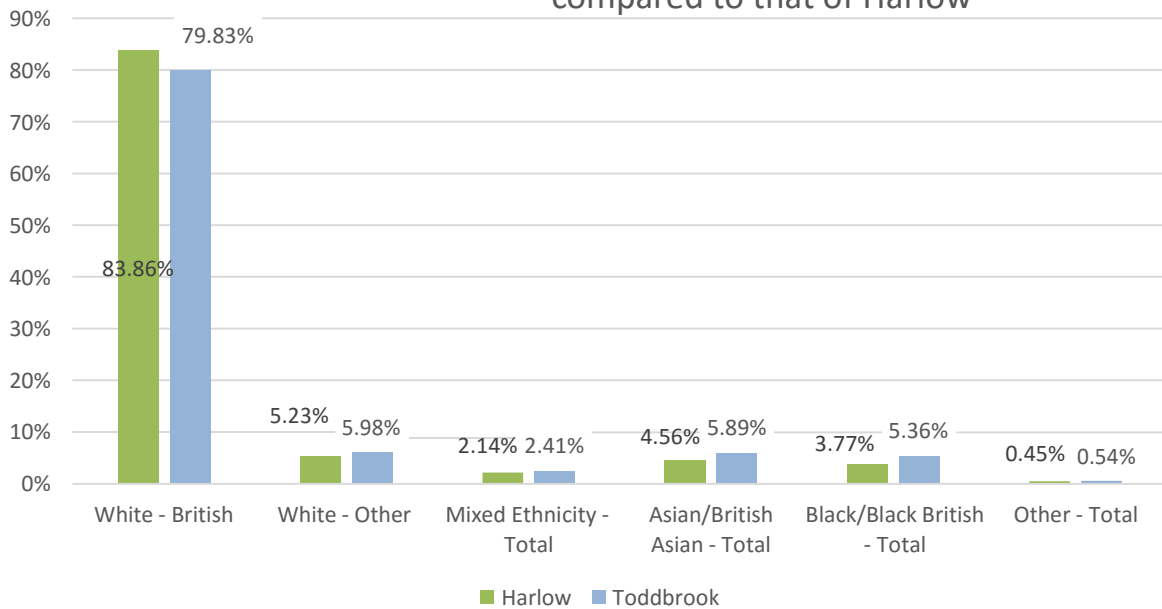
### Ethnic composition of Toddbrook

### Toddbrook's ethnic composition compared to that of Harlow

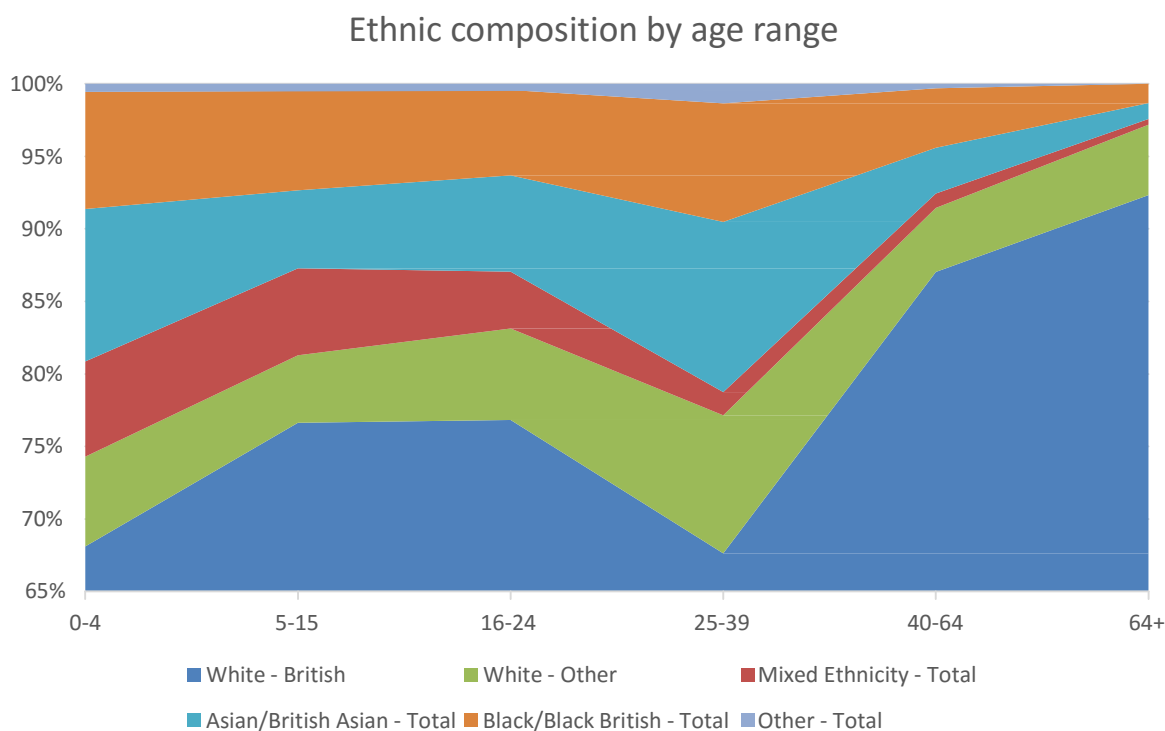


## Ethnicity by Age

*White British* is the predominant ethnic group in each age range in Toddbrook. However the proportion of each ethnic group varies significantly through the age bands, as seen in the proportional area graph below.

Of the population aged 0 to 4 years of age, the proportion of *White British* residents is 68%, whilst for the population aged 64 and above, the proportion rises to 92%.

Almost 11% of residents under 5 years of age are of *Asian/Asian British* ethnicity, yet in 2001 less than 4% of infants were of *Asian/Asian British* ethnicity.

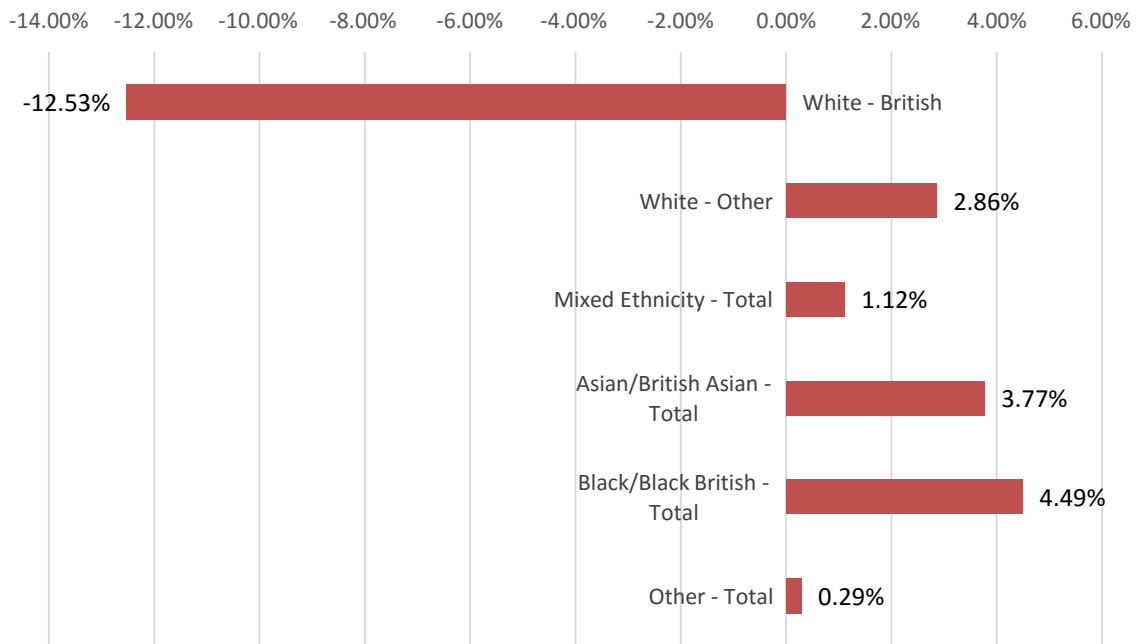

# Nationalities

## Trends

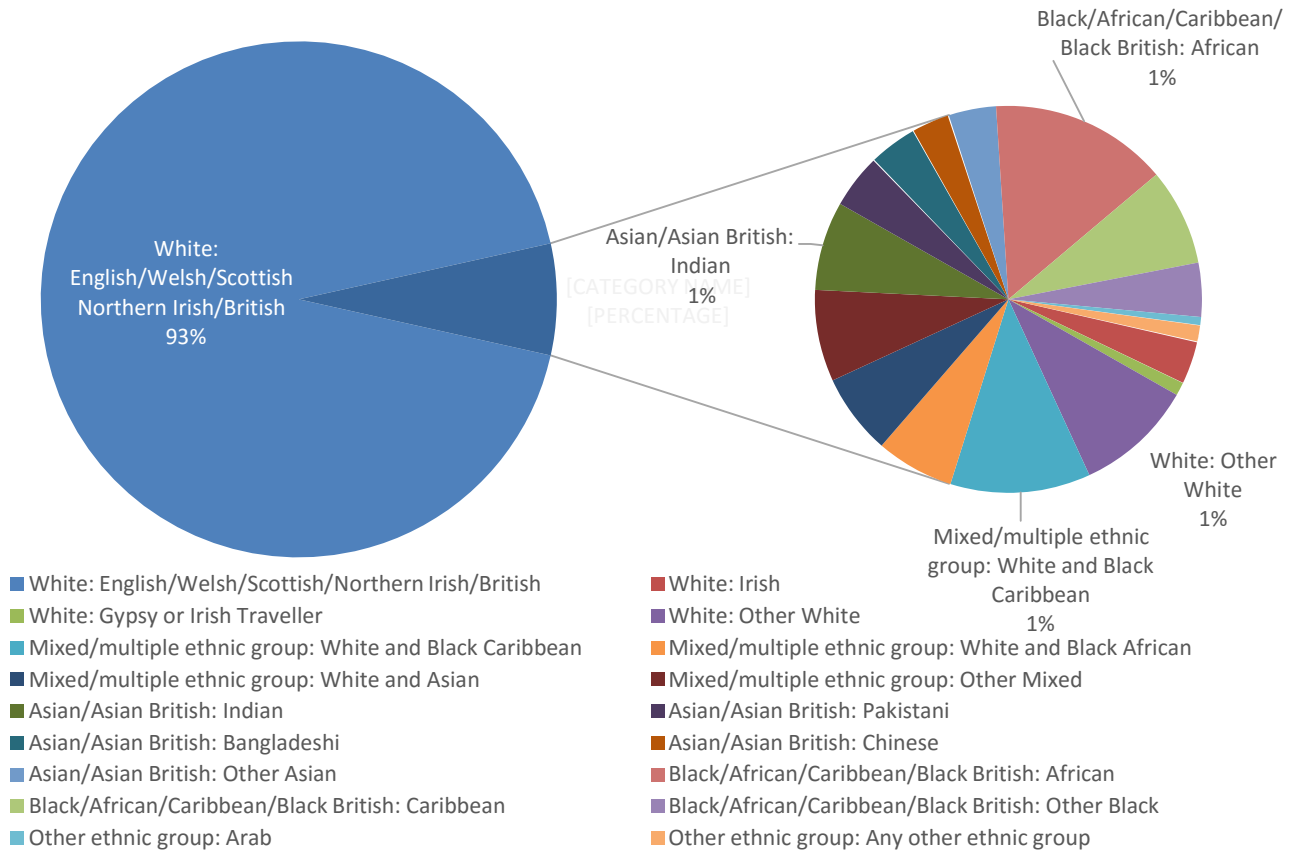
Like the majority of wards and Harlow as a whole, Toddbrook saw its population of residents born in the United Kingdom decline, both proportionally and in real terms.

The decade also saw significant growth in the populations of people from countries recently admitted to the EU and from Southern Asia.

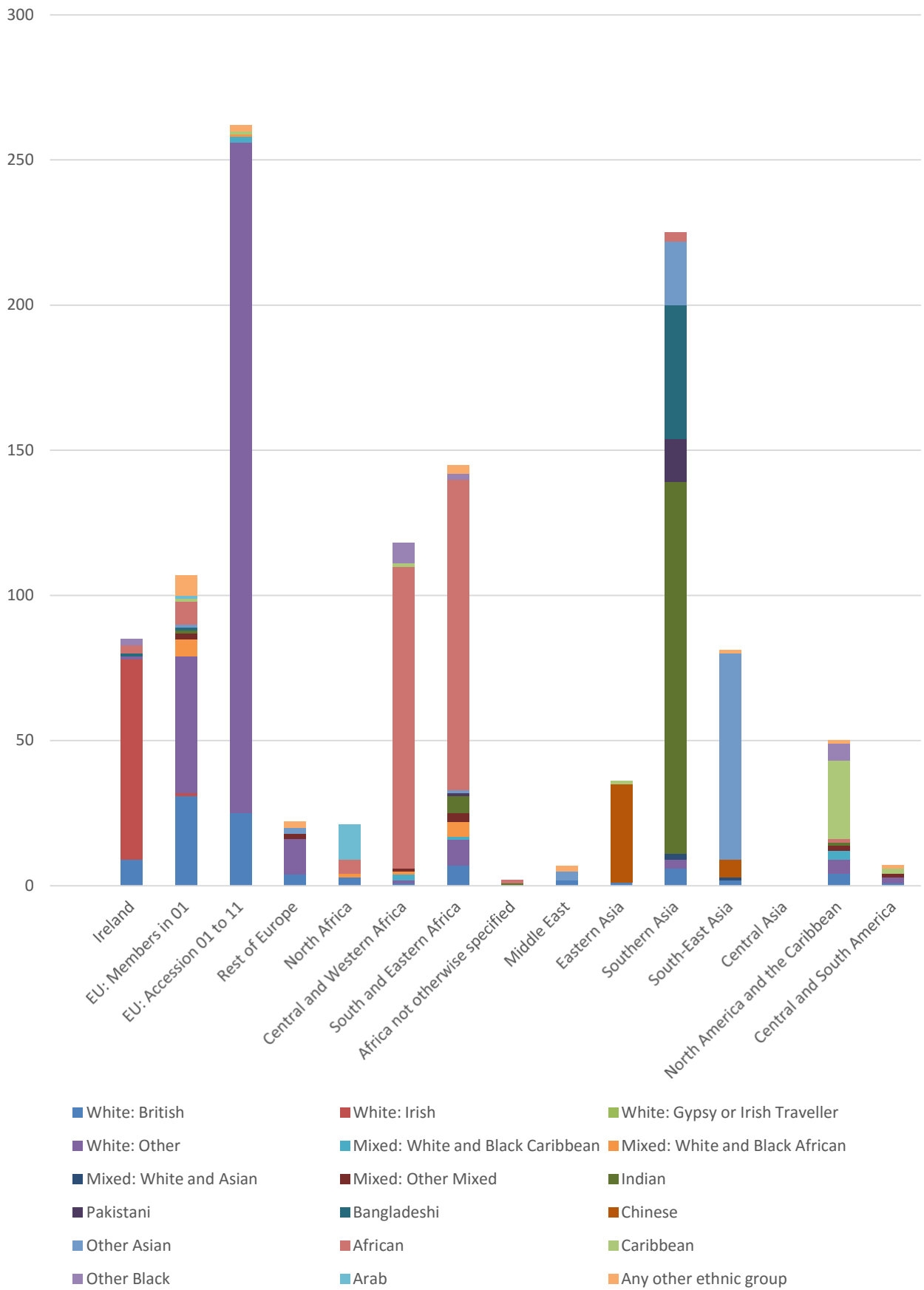

## Ethnic composition of Toddbrook's nationalities (excluding UK)



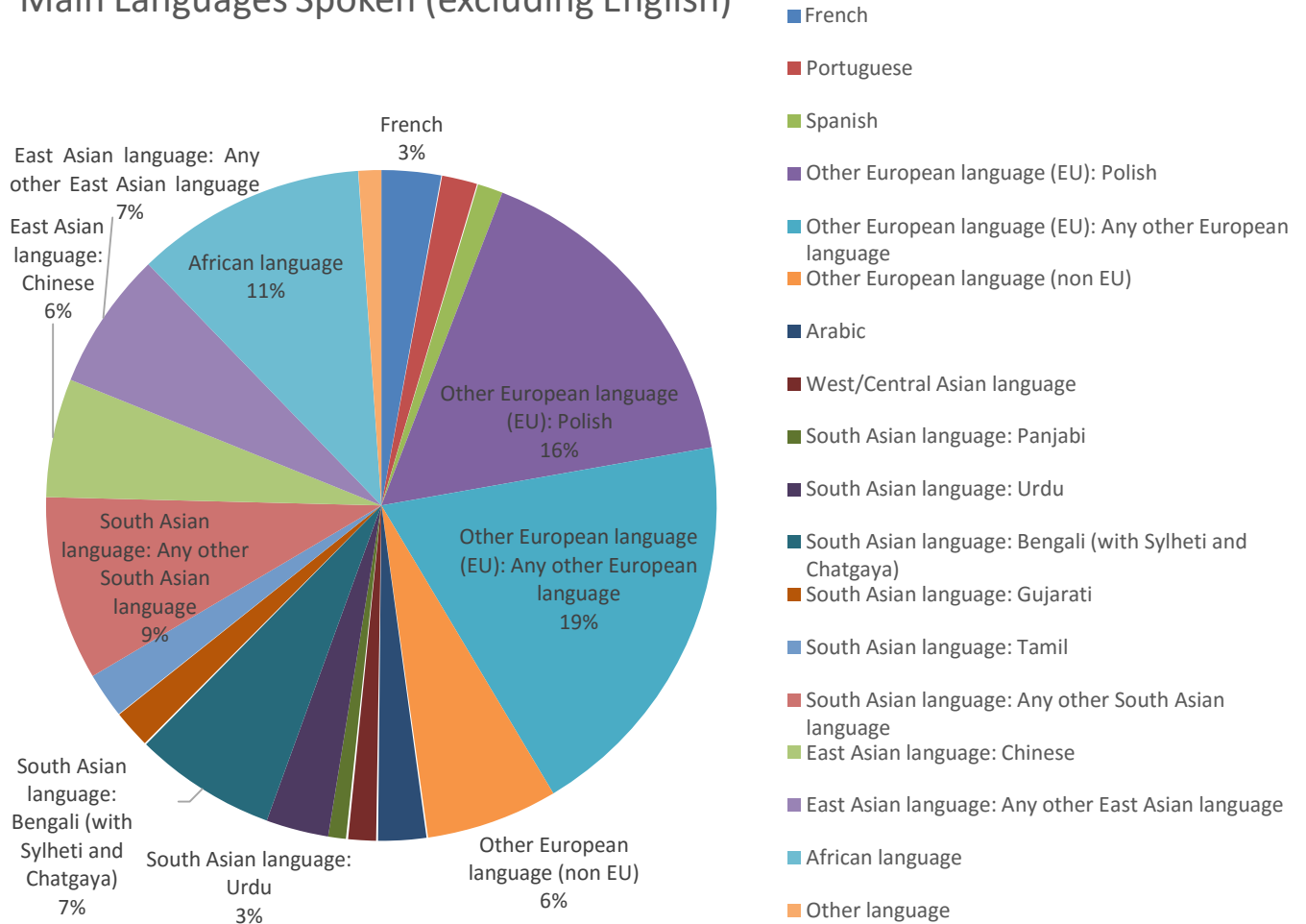
## Languages spoken

## Proficiency in English

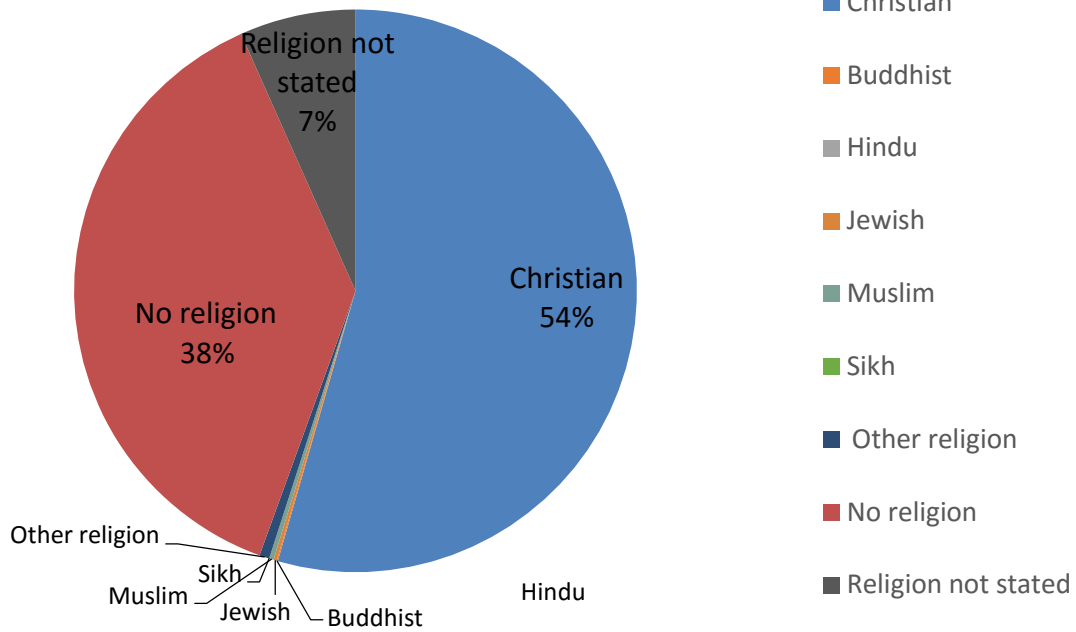

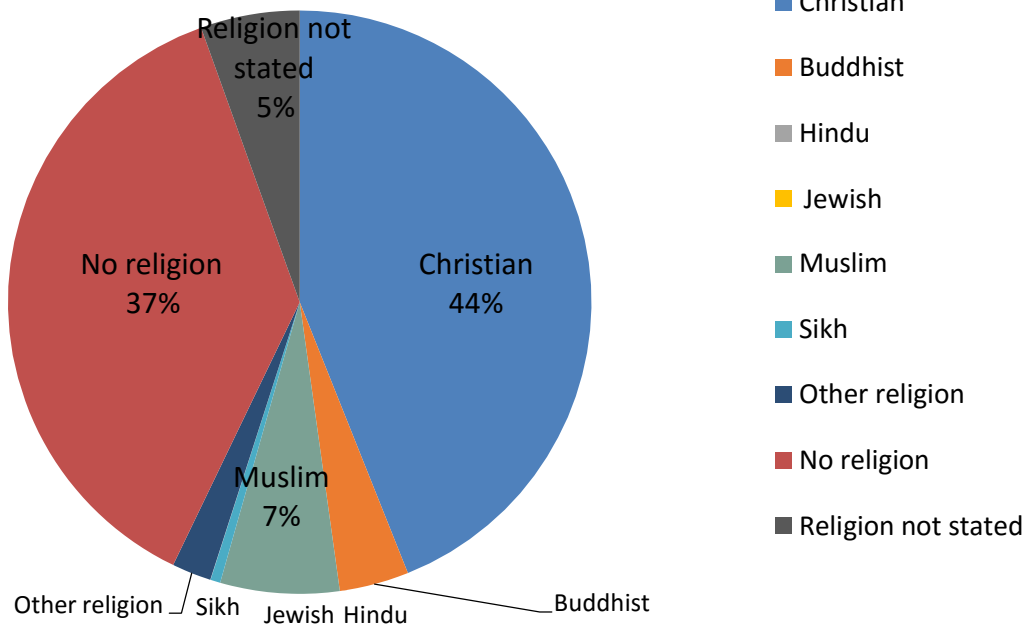
Since 2001 the number of Christians in Toddbrook has fallen by over 13%. This is a slightly slower rate of decline than in Harlow overall, which saw the number of Christians decrease by over 14%. 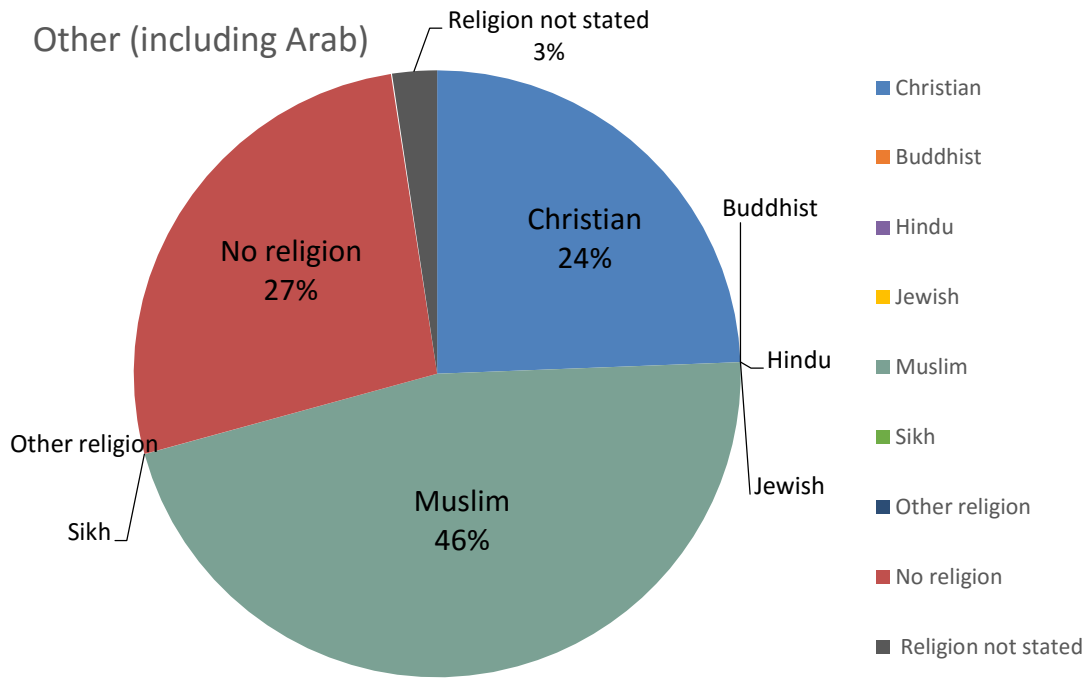

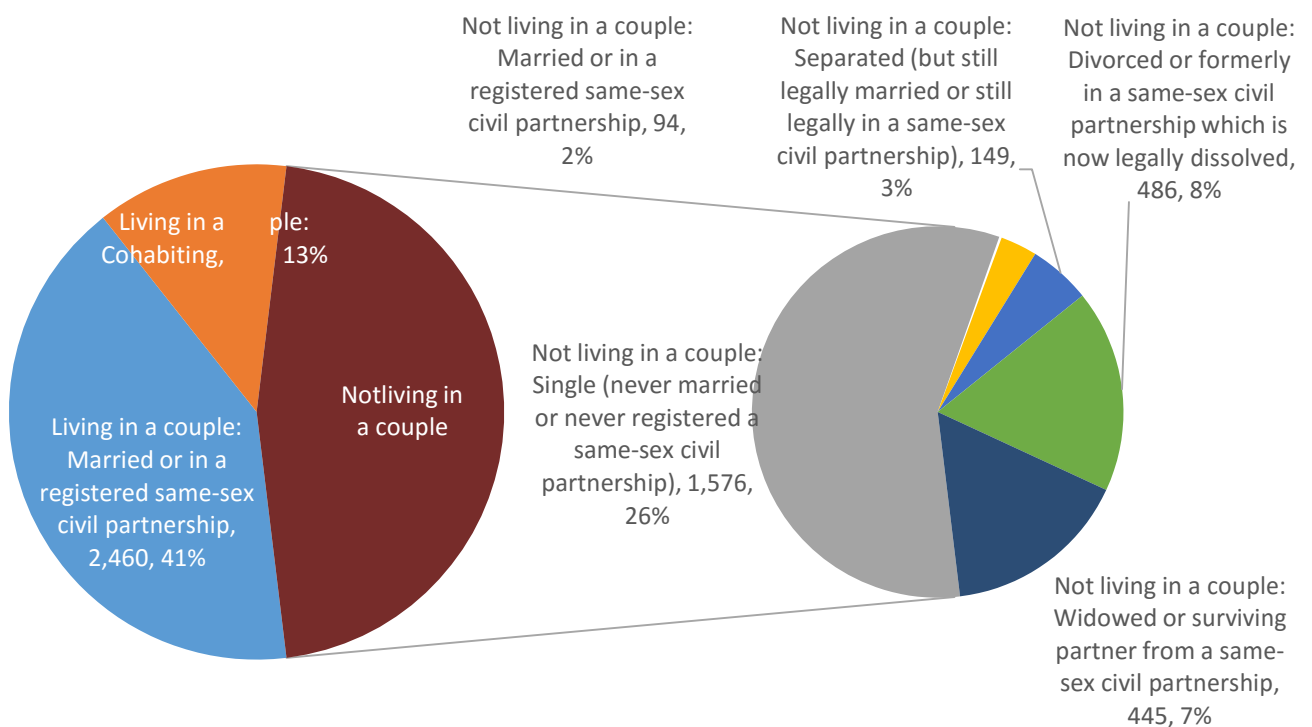

Of Toddbrook's residents aged 16 and over, 54% are living as a couple; the majority of whom are either married or living in a civil partnership.

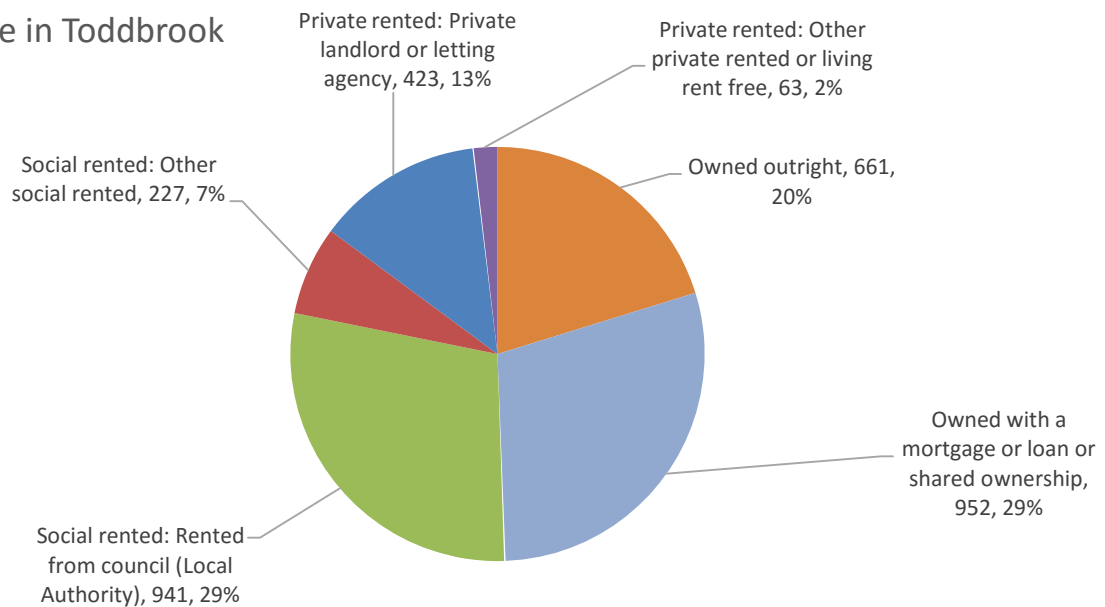


# Tenure

Of Toddbrook’s 3267 households, 49% of properties are either owned outright or owned with a mortgage or loan. This is significantly lower than Harlow overall, where 57% of residents own their dwelling.

Toddbrook’s proportion of social tenure is in line with Harlow as a whole. Though those renting from the council accounts for 29% of all households, whereas across Harlow 27% of all dwellings are rented from the council.

## Tenure across age groups

As expected, ownership varies greatly across the various ages bands. Amongst residents aged 16-34 only 2% own their dwelling outright and only 23% own with a mortgage or through shared ownership. For residents over 64 years of age, 57% own their dwellings of which 49% own them outright.

## Qualifications

Toddbrook's levels of education are slightly lower than those of Harlow overall. 17% of residents over 16 have achieved Level 4 qualifications or above compared to 18% in the Town as a whole.

Likewise, 28% of the ward's residents have no qualifications compared to 26% across Harlow.

## Trends

During the decade 2001 to 2011 there was a significant decrease in the proportion of Harlow's population who held no qualifications, with an overall proportional decline of approximately 6%. This was mirrored in Toddbrook where the proportion of residents without qualifications also fell by 6%.

## Economic Activity

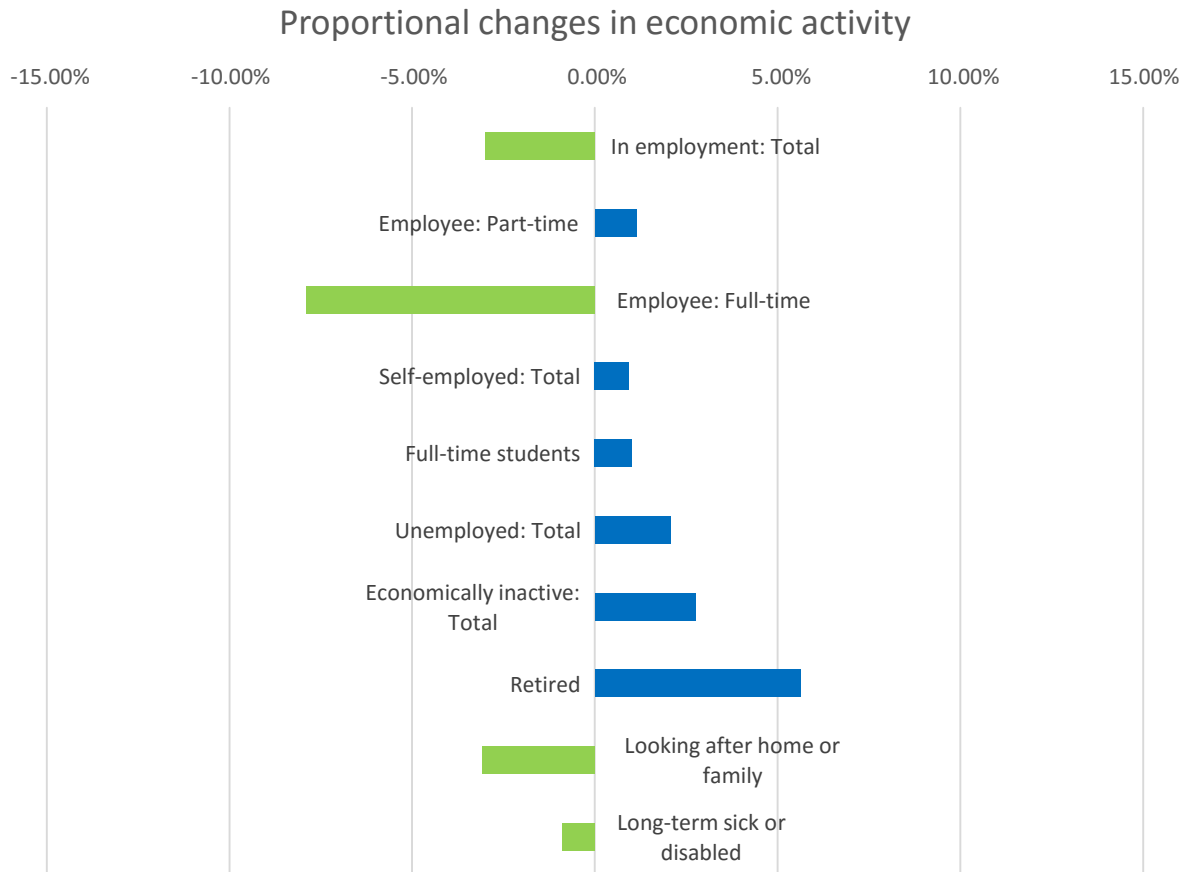

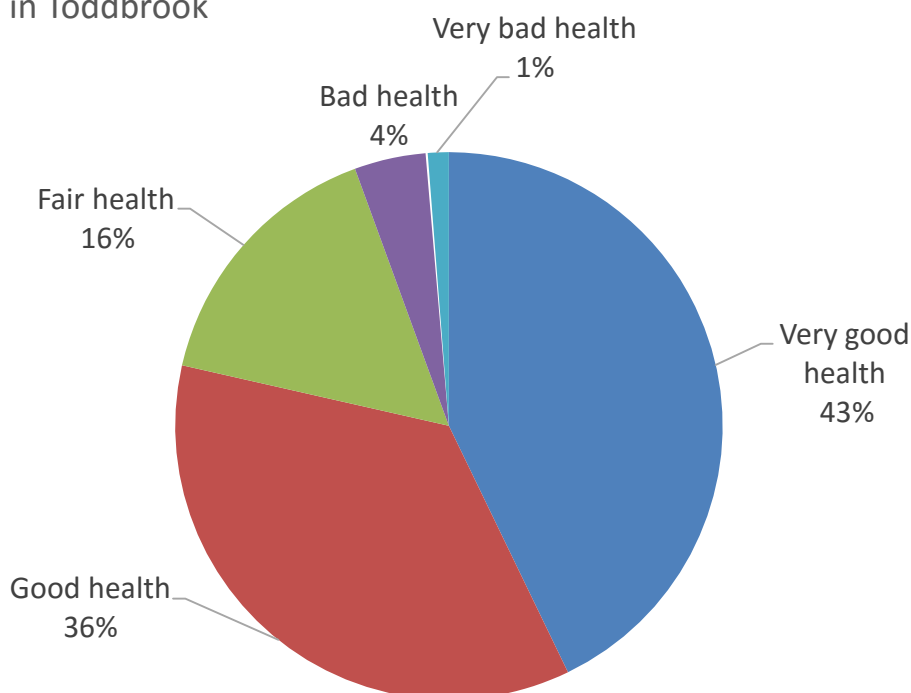
# Disability and Health

Health in Toddbrook



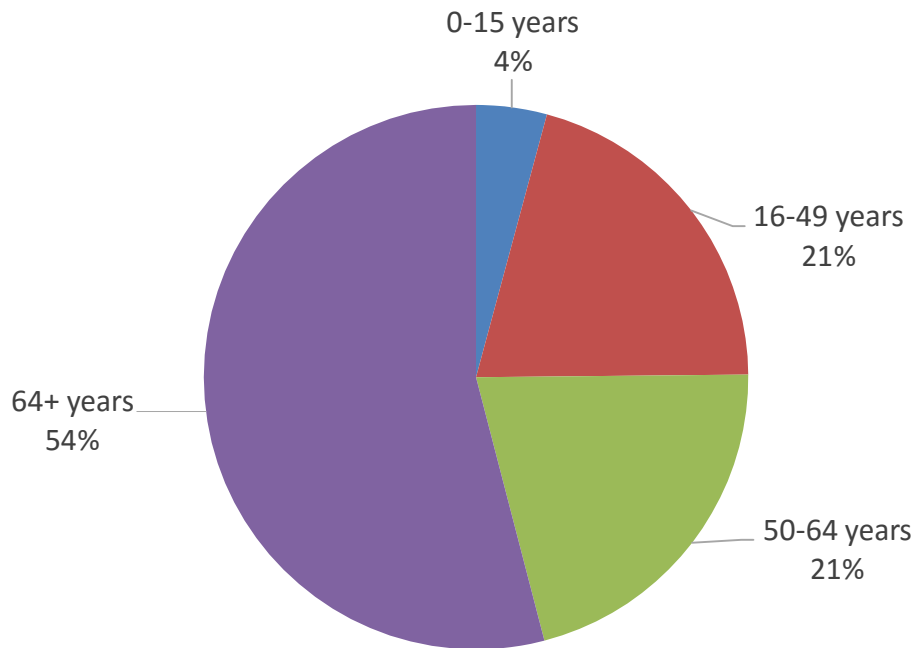

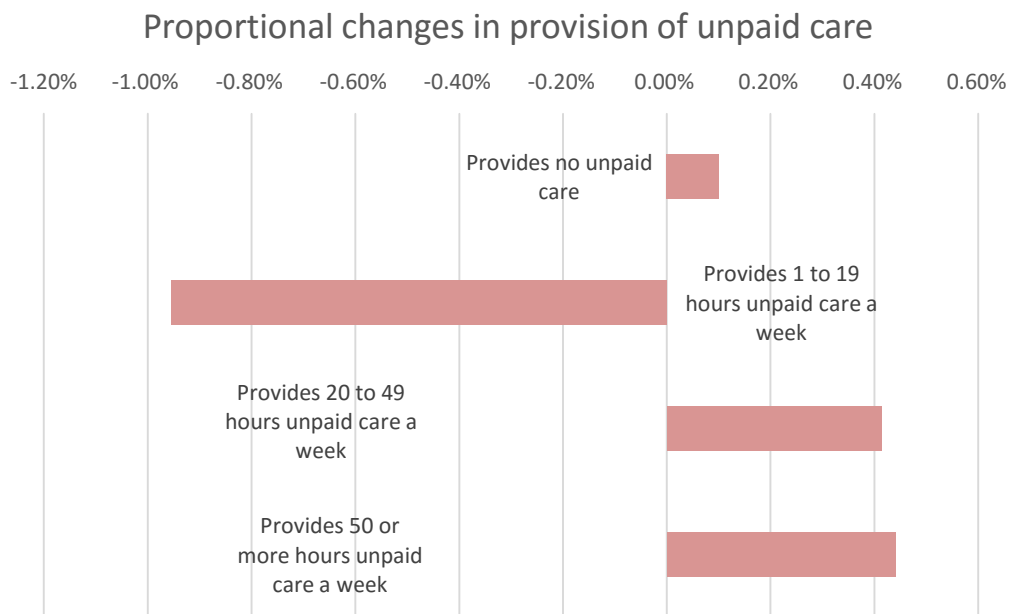

## Trends

Since 2001 the proportion of people providing unpaid care has decreased marginally, whereas for every other ward and for Harlow as a whole, the proportion of people providing unpaid care has increased.
