Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 11, 12, 14, and 35 of The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) and pursuant to Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 that the Affordable and Specialist Housing Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by Harlow District Council on 14th October 2021.

The SPD provides further advice on how relevant housing policies relating to affordable housing, specialist housing, and self-build/custom housing in the adopted local plan are to be implemented including expectations associated with affordable and local needs housing for the district. The consultation statement associated with this Adoption Statement sets out modifications made to the SPD in account of representations received during consultation.
