It will provide officers with a means of calculating the commuted sums, which will be used as the basis for negotiation with developers and others submitting planning applications for housing that should incorporate affordable dwellings. The Consultation Statement associated with this Adoption Statement sets out modifications if any are subsequently made to the draft SPD, to take account of representations received during the consultation.
