Notice is hereby given that Harlow District Council is to conduct a statutory review of the polling districts and polling places in accordance with Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by Section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013).

The review will be conducted between 17 May and 21 June 2024

The (Acting) Returning Officer will make comment on the current arrangements within the district and publish any proposed changes.

The details of all the representations received will be made available for inspection on the Councils website or by visiting the Electoral Services office by appointment in accordance with the legislation.

The Council welcomes comments from all residents or any person representing electors, particularly any person or organisation with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability.

Persons or organisations making representations should, if possible, give details of suitable alternative venues that may be used as polling stations.

Final proposals will be considered at the full council meeting on 25 July 2024, and if approved, any changes will come into effect immediately.
