- Offences under the Food Safety legislation catering vendors only
- Offence under Copyright, Designs and Patents legislation
- Offences of Forgery and Counterfeiting
- Offences under Customs and Excise legislation
- Trade Description offences
- Theft and theft related offences
- Any licensing offence under Street Trading or other relevant legislation.
- Limited driving offences (Mobile licences only)
- Any other offence that may be deemed relevant on a case by case basis.

When considering cautions or convictions the Rehabilitation of Offenders Legislation will be taken into consideration.

Consideration may also be given to the applicant's conduct as a Street Trader.

Where there is concern that an applicant is not suitable the application will become contentious and dealt with accordingly.

How information about you will be used
