

## Building Control Account

The Building (Local Authority charges) regulations 1998 require the disclosure of information regarding the setting of charges for the administration of the building control function.

The Council sets charges with the aim of ensuring that over a rolling 3-year accounting period the income received recovers the cost of providing the service. Certain activities cannot be charged for, such as providing general advice.

The statement below shows the total cost of operating the building control function for 2016/2017 (together with 2015/2016 figures for comparable purposes).
